This **Inside Track to the Pennsylvania Derby** wagering guide gives you an inside look at the *eight stakes* running at Parx Racing on September 25, 2021, including a pair of \$1 million races: the Pennsylvania Derby (G1) and the Cotillion (G1).

The Racing Dudes have been at it for over 9 years, offering daily handicapping picks and analysis for every track across the country. For this year's **Inside Track to the Pennsylvania Derby**, our lead handicappers have been scouring through the card at Parx in search of winning tickets on this loaded day of racing.

Along with the Pennsylvania Derby and Cotillion, the other stakes on the card are the \$300,000 Gallant Bob (G2), the \$300,000 Turf Monster (G3), the \$200,000 Greenwood Cup (G3), the \$200,000 Alphabet Soup, the \$200,000 Plum Pretty, and the \$200,000 Parx Dirt Mile.

But that's not all! Along with the eight major stakes races, this Inside Track to the Pennsylvania Derby wagering guide also includes race-by-race analysis, betting suggestions, and multi-race plays for Parx's entire Saturday card.

RACE 6: PLUM PRETTY STAKES

1 1/16 MILES (DIRT)
FILLIES & MARES
3~YEAR~OLDS & UPWARD (PA BRED)
\$200,000



OVERVIEW:

The Pennsylvania-bred fillies take to the track to start off the day's stakes action, and with a pretty evenly-matched field, we could definitely find a price or two. Let's start strong in the first of eight straight stakes races!

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Chub Wagon*

Pressing Speed: *Promised Storm*

Stalkers: *Precious, Marion Francis, Amen Sylvia*

Closers: *Vault, Ninetypercentbrynn, Trolley Ride*

What a weird spot for Chub Wagon, who usually runs in sprint races but stretches out to two turns here. She'll be on the lead and should dictate the early pace, but the rest of these horses could be able to run with her.

TOP CHOICE: #1 VAULT

The last time Joel Rosario was aboard her, she won the Ruffian Stakes (G3) at Belmont Park. She lost 3 straight since, but she did run decently in the local prep race. Chub Wagon is the most talented horse in the field, but she's also unproven at the distance, whereas Vault will be just fine going 1 1/16 miles around two turns.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 Precious, #6 Chub Wagon, #7 Marion Francis

Precious won the local prep race and will be tough once again here. Chub Wagon is easily the best horse in the race, but this will be her first start going two turns. Marion Francis takes on older horses for the first time.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 Promised Storm

She stretches back out in distance after running second behind Chub Wagon in a sprint stakes. This extra distance might help her turn the tables and she could provide value against a tricky field.

OTHERS: #3 Ninetypercentbrynn, #5 Trolley Ride, #8 Amen Sylvia

There is no doubt this race could get weird, especially if a couple of the favorites don't show up with their best efforts. Even if that happens, though, it still looks like this group will have a hard time making an impact.

BET TO WIN: #1 Vault - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

BET TO PLACE: #6 Chub Wagon - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

RACE 7: PARX DIRT MILE STAKES

OVERVIEW:

A nice \$200,000 purse awaits this field going 1 mile on the dirt. Parx did an exceptional job attracting quality horses to enter not only the two big Grade 1 events, but the smaller stakes races on the card as well.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Dreams Untold, Rock On Luke*

Pressing Speed: *Mind Control, Thorny Tale, Warrior's Charge*

Stalkers: *West Will Power*

Closers: *Silver State, Informative*

Two pretty fast horses in this race should go early and two other ones shouldn't be too far behind them. That should speed this race up and make it a tricky event to handicap.

TOP CHOICE: #6 SILVER STATE

If you look up "consistency" in the dictionary, you see this guy's picture. He's been awesome all season, winning 5 straight including the Met Mile (G1) at Belmont Park 2 starts back. Last time out, he finished a solid third in the Whitney Stakes (G1), losing to two horses who will likely be short prices in the Breeders' Cup Classic. He should simply outclass this group.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 West Will Power, #3 Mind Control, #4 Thorny Tale

West Hill Power ran well last time out, finishing second to Code of Honor at Monmouth Park. Multiple Grade 1-winning sprinter Mind Control stretches out in distance, which is his main question mark. Thorny Tale has won 2 in a row over this track.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Dreams Untold, #7 Warrior's Charge

Dreams Untold runs third off the layoff in this spot for solid Parx connections. Warrior's Charge has been wildly inconsistent this season, but his best race makes him competitive here. Cutting back to a mile should also help his chances.

OTHERS: #5 Rock On Luck, #8 Informative

These two look a little overmatched against what is a pretty salty field. They'll need to improve their form to have a shot here.

RACE 8: GREENWOOD CUP STAKES (G3)

1 1/2 MILES (DIRT)
3~YEAR~OLDS & UPWARD
\$200,000



OVERVIEW:

Get comfortable before watching this race because it could take a while, with this field going a grueling 12 furlongs on dirt. Races like this can be tricky to handicap, so make sure you look for horses who you think can run this grueling distance successfully.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Sheer Flattery, Sea Foam*

Pressing Speed: *Moretti, Magic Michael*

Stalkers: *Lookin At Roses, Last Samurai*

Closers: *Forewarned, Math Wizard, Shooger Ray Too*

This race has more early pace than what's normally seen in dirt marathons; however, it still won't be super fast until the late stages. These races usually end up being a sprint to the finish.

TOP CHOICE: #8 SEA FOAM

He comes into this race off of 2 straight impressive victories, both of which have come at 1 1/8 miles. He'll have to stretch out in distance for this one, but he's bred to do so, and he could get loose on the lead. If he gets the right trip, then he should be able to easily take this field gate to wire. It's also a positive sign that Joel Rosario will be aboard once again.

MAJOR THREATS: #3 Moretti, #5 Shooger Ray Too, #7 Sheer Flattery

Moretti is definitely the class of the field; however, we haven't seen his best efforts lately. Shooger Ray Too ran well at this distance last time out, finishing second in a Saratoga stakes. Sheer Flattery has won 3 straight coming into this race.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Magic Michael, #6 Lookin At Roses

Magic Michael has won 3 straight at Parx and should be happy to run over this track again. Lookin At Roses is a consistent runner who should like stretching out. This is a tougher field than what he usually faces, but he fits from a speed figure standpoint.

OTHERS: #1 Forewarned, #2 Math Wizard, #9 Last Samurai

These horse can be competitive on their best days, but we haven't seen them run a top race in quite some time.

RACE 9: TURF MONSTER STAKES (G3)

OVERVIEW:

The Turf Monster is a staple of the Parx racing season each and every year. The list of past winners is impressive and this year's field looks pretty solid. This is not an official Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" event, but it could definitely play a factor in the Turf Sprint regardless.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: Smooth B, Carotari, Firecrow, Admiral Abe

Pressing Speed: West Fork, Belgrano, Caravel

Stalkers: Beer Can Man, Amblin Man, Battle Station

Closers: The Connector, Hollywood Talent

Like any usual turf sprint, this race should have a pretty hot pace up front. Several of these want to be forwardly placed, so the horses who can sit just off the early pace should have the advantage.

TOP CHOICE: #8 CARAVEL

We'll see if this filly can bounce back from a lackluster effort last time out at Woodbine in the Highlander Stakes (G1). Before that race, she won 3 straight impressively that catapulted her to the top of this division. Sometimes the Woodbine turf course can play tough to newcomers, which could have been the problem last time out. If she bounces back, then she'll be tough to beat in this spot.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Beer Can Man, #4 Carotari, #5 Firecrow, #9 Battle Station

Beer Can Man looked solid off the layoff last time out, winning a Del Mar allowance impressively. Carotari always runs well in these types of races. Firecrow was an ultra-impressive winner of the Jim McKay Turf Sprint last time out. Battle Station was second in the local prep for this event.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #7 Belgrano, #12 Admiral Abe

Belgrano won 2 in a row at Monmouth Park with ease to earn his shot against this tougher field. Admiral Abe comes into this race hot while also getting back to the turf. He offers value despite a poor post position.

OTHERS: #2 Amblin Man, #3 Smooth B, #6 West Fork, #10 The Connector, #11 Hollywood Talent

Many of these horses do have a chance in what could turn into a wide-open scramble. We just prefer others a bit more.

RACE 10- GALLANT BOB STAKES (G2)

OVERVIEW:

This card does a great job highlighting many great 3-year-olds, starting with this talented field. The dirt sprint division has been ultra-exciting all season long and we expect no difference here, with the best sprinter in the country (regardless of age) entered.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: Jackie's Warrior

Pressing Speed: Real Talk, Beren

Stalkers: Newbomb, Awesome Jerry

Closers: Pickin' Time, Marvalous Mike

The pace will be fast here, mainly because Jackie's Warrior is just naturally speedy, so he'll get out and set the pace. He shouldn't have much pressure, though, which is bad news for the rest of the field.

TOP CHOICE: #7 JACKIE'S WARRIOR

This is one of the most talented horses in training, so it's very exciting to see him back running in this spot. After suffering a loss three races back at Belmont Park, this horse has put up back to back monster efforts, winning the Amsterdam Stakes (G2) and Allen Jerkens Stakes (G1) at Saratoga. If he shows up with that kind of effort today, he'll make short work of this field, on his way to being the morning line favorite in the Breeders' Cup Sprint.

MAJOR THREATS: #6 Beren

He won 4 out of his last 5 races and 2 of those victories came over this track. He'll have to move up in class in a big way here, but if the heavy favorite stubs his toe, then this horse should be around waiting to pull the upset.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Real Talk

This horse won 2 of his last 3 starts including a stakes at Monmouth Park last time out. He may not be able to match up with our top choice, but if for some reason Jackie's Warrior struggles, he'll have a shot to pull the upset.

OTHERS: #2 Newbomb, #3 Awesome Jerry, #4 Pickin' Time, #5 Marvalous Mike

Simply put, these horses look completely overmatched by Jackie's Warrior. They'll need him to show up with a very poor effort in order to have a chance.

OVERVIEW:

This year's Cotillion attracted several of the big-time 3-year-old fillies in a deep field. This might be one of the most underrated races each year, as the list of winners is very impressive. Will any of these runners parlay a victory into a trip to the Breeders' Cup?

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Always Carina*

Pressing Speed: *Will's Secret*

Stalkers: *Army Wife*

Closers: *Obligatory, Allworthy, Maracuja, Clairiere, Leader of the Band*

With the scratch of Private Mission, we now have Always Carina loose on the lead in this race. That could make her extra tough to catch on a track that favors speed.

TOP CHOICE: #8 ALWAYS CARINA

At one time, this was the next up and coming star for Chad Brown, but there is no doubt she has struggled in her last two races. However, today she is likely to get a very good set up, with her being the lone speed in the race. If she can get out to a nice early lead, getting comfortable on the front end, she might be able to take this field gate to wire at a nice price.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Obligatory, #5 Army Wife, #6 Clairiere

Obligatory is interesting while stretching out in distance, as her best races have been at 7 furlongs. Army Wife has been solid in her last few races, winning 2 before finishing second in a Grade 1. Clairiere has been ultra-consistent all year but has had trouble winning.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Maracuja

Maracuja pulled off a major upset 2 starts back in the Coaching Club American Oaks (G1), but that may have been a fluke. Her other races have left a lot to be desired, so oddly enough, this race still seems to be a proving ground for her.

OTHERS: #2 Allworthy, #3 Will's Secret, #9 Leader of the Band

Out of this group, Will's Secret seems to be the most interesting of the group. However, we haven't seen her best race in quite a while, so she has to reverse her form in a major way here.

BET TO WIN: #8 Always Carina - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

OVERVIEW:

The main event is here, and wow, this year's Pennsylvania Derby drew an impressive field. Several of these runners have made major headlines all year long (some for the wrong reasons), but one of the most intriguing Penn Derby fields in recent memory is also one of the deepest that we've seen all season from the 3-year-old division.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Hot Rod Charlie, Midnight Bourbon, Weyburn*

Pressing Speed: *Americanrevolution*

Stalkers: *Speaker's Corner, I Am Redeemed*

Closers: *Fulsome, Keepmeinmind, Bourbonic*

The scratch of Medina Spirit definitely slows the original pace setup; however, there is still a lot of speed signed on to run. It won't be blazing, but the closers should have a chance if they're good enough.

TOP CHOICE: #7 HOT ROD CHARLIE

It's time for this horse to finally have some good luck in one of these big races. Two starts back, he ran too good to lose in the Belmont Stakes (G1) but had to settle for second. Last start, he outdueled Mandaloun to win the Haskell Stakes (G1), only to be disqualified and placed last because he tripped Midnight Bourbon. He's proven over and over to be one of the top horses in this crop, now he just needs to finish the job and do it cleanly.

MAJOR THREATS: #3 Speaker's Corner, #8 Midnight Bourbon

Speaker's Corner returned off of a long layoff last time out, impressively winning a Saratoga allowance. Midnight Bourbon keeps showing up with strong efforts in all the big races but just can't quite finish the deal. We know he'll show up with a solid effort.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 Keepmeinmind, #10 Americanrevolution

Keepmeinmind has been in all the big races but just can't seem to finish in front. Still, he's a great horse to use underneath. Americanrevolution is progressing nicely for Todd Pletcher but must take a giant step up in class, which is his major question mark.

OTHERS: #1 Fulsome, #4 Weyburn, #5 I Am Redeemed, #6 Bourbonic

This group looks a bit overmatched in this extremely tough Pennsylvania Derby. It would be a surprise if any of these made an impact.

BET TO WIN: #7 Hot Rod Charlie - Confidence Level: 4 out of 5

ALPHABET SOUP HANDICAP

1 1/16 MILES (TURF)
3-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD (PA BRED)
\$200,000



OVERVIEW:

We're on the turf for this final event that could produce a price between the fairly evenly-matched group on paper and the fact that Parx turf racing can sometimes be tricky. The racing on this card looks competitive all the way through and this race should be a fun betting event.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Saratoga Jack, Wait for It*

Pressing Speed: *Papal Law, Prince of Rain, Missin the Big Dog*

Stalkers: *Stonegate*

Closers: *You Must Chill, Irish Cork, Someday Jones, Saint Marco, Viski Jones*

Most east coast turf routes produce slow paces and this one should as well, unless some of the stalkers decide to change tactics.

TOP CHOICE: #1 YOU MUST CHILL

You can go a million different ways in what looks like the most wide-open stakes on the card. On top, we'll go with the horse who just won impressively on the turf last time out, defeating allowance company at Penn National. This is a step up in class, but this field leaves a lot to be desired, especially since several of these horses have not run well on grass in the past.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Stonegate, #3 Irish Cork, #10 Missin the Big Dog

Stonegate is a consistent runner in these types of spots. Getting back to turf should help. Irish Cork makes his turf debut in this spot. He has solid breeding for the surface. Missin the Big Dog consistently runs well on any surface.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Saratoga Jack, #8 Someday Jones

Saratoga Jack returns to the turf, which seems to be his best surface. Someday Jones also returns to the turf after a prolonged dirt career. His breeding suggests he might handle the surface well and his talent level seems high.

OTHERS: #5 Papal Law, #6 Prince of Rain, #7 Wait for It, #9 Saint Marco, #11 Viski Jones

This race is completely wide open, so don't be afraid to use any of these horses if you like them. This is the most likely stakes to produce a big price.
