It's time for the first big event of the year! The Pegasus World Cup is finally here and the Dudes are ready to go! This year, we're going to once again give you the **EXACT** race-by-race wagering plan of Aaron and Jared, who will be betting the Pegasus card throughout the day. You can play these tickets exactly, or you can take our opinions and sprinkle in your own thoughts as well. The decision is up to you. We shot for an approximate \$300 budget.

Let's not waste any more time. Here's our wagering plan for all 7 stakes races on the card:

Race #5: LA PREVOYANTE

Let's try to get a bit creative to start. We both like the favorite #4 Always Shopping, but not enough to bet the win at what will be a short price. We'll wheel her on top with #9 Honor Hop, then sprinkle #6 Beautiful Lover and #1 Sorrel in the second and third spots.

We'll start a Pick 3 here because we have some strong opinions in these next races. Let's play #5 King Cause, #9 Glynn County, and #10 Abaan in this leg. In leg two, we'll play #5 Four Graces and #8 Just One Time. In the final leg, we'll single #4 Regal Glory, our strongest play of the day.

RACE No 5:

La Prevoyante Stakes (G3)

1 1/2 MILES (TURF)
Fillies & Mares
4-Year-Olds & Upward
\$150,000

OVERVIEW:

Marathon races on the turf have become the norm on the Pegasus World Cup Day Card, with this race and the W. L. McKnight being big highlights each year. This year, we have another good field ready to go in this spot, which could lead to some exciting results. The La Prevoyante will kick off the stakes action today!

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Always Shopping*

Pressing Speed: *Beautiful Lover, Honor Hop*

Stalkers: *Niceno, Scarabea*

Closers: *Sorrel, Sister Otoole, Onyx, Hungry Kitten*

We could have a lonely leader on the turf in this spot. Defending champion Always Shopping dominated this race last year, and could very well do the same thing again this season.

TOP CHOICE: #4 ALWAYS SHOPPING

The defending champion is back for more this year, and won the local prep for this race last time out. She came into last year's event super sharp, and now it looks like she could be rounding into form at the perfect time for this race. Looking at the pace, it seems as though she will be on or near the lead, and there is no doubt she will be the one they have to run down when turning for home.

MAJOR THREATS: #6 Beautiful Lover, #9 Honor Hop

Beautiful Lover is a consistent horse that always seems to show up with decent effort. Rosario gets aboard today, which is a good sign. Honor Hop moves up in class today, but looks like she is ready to handle the challenge.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #8 Hungry Kitten

If the pace heats up in here, which isn't expected, this horse looks to be the best closer in the race. She also has been on the improve lately, which makes her a bit interesting if the price floats up.

OTHERS: #1 Sorrel, #2 Sister Otoole, #3 Onyx, #5 Niceno, #7 Scarabea

This group isn't over matched, but we just prefer others a bit more in this spot. We will likely roll the dice hard with Always Shopping in the multi-race sequences.

RACE No. 7:

W.L. MCKNIGHT STAKES (G3)

1 1/2 MILES (TURF)
4-Year-Olds & Upward
\$200,000

OVERVIEW:

This race has become a staple on the Pegasus World Cup card each season. It has been known to produce some prices, which was good for us last year, with Tide of the Sea getting the job done for us in gate-to-wire fashion. This year's version is another good one, so we'll see if we can get another good price home.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: Temple, Abaan

Pressing Speed: Oriental Trigger, King Cause

Stalkers: Farmington Road, Bakers Bay

Closers: Media Blitz, Bama Breeze, Mandate, Glynn County, In Effect, Sole Volante

We won't see blazing speed in this race; however, there still should be enough to keep this race fair and honest, giving the closers a shot in this spot.

TOP CHOICE: #9 GLYNN COUNTY

It was tough trying to decide what Mike Maker horse we wanted to put on top here, but in the end, Glynn County was the choice. His last race was not good; however, past that effort he has been a very consistent horse, while taking on tough company. The pace should set up pretty well for him in this spot, and you have to love that Gaffalione is aboard for the ride.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Temple, #5 King Cause, #6 Bama Breeze, #10 Abaan

Temple is back in the barn of Mike Maker, so expect to see him back to his old self. King Cause was a solid allowance winner at Aqueduct last time out, and seems ready for this jump up in class. Bama Breeze was solid in his last stakes attempt at Keeneland. Abaan comes into this race red hot, winning two races in a row impressively.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Farmington Road, #4 Media Blitz, #8 Bakers Bay

Farmington Road should love the distance. Media Blitz can win in this spot if he can rebound from a poor effort last time out. His trainer is a turf marathon specialist. Bakers Bay always seems to show up with a solid effort in these spots.

OTHERS: #2 Oriental Trigger, #7 Mandate, #11 In Effect, #12 Sole Volante

This group looks to be a little overmatched in what turned out to be an excellent field this year.

7 FURLONGS (DIRT)
Fillies & Mares
4-Year-Olds & Upward
\$200,000

INSIDE INFORMATION STAKES (G2)

OVERVIEW:

The sprinting dirt females take center stage in this spot, which drew a solid field once again this year. Over the years, this race has produced some big prices on Pegasus World Cup day, and this field can certainly live up to that same billing. This really looks to be a solid betting affair.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: A G Indy, Four Graces, Just One Time

Pressing Speed: Jakarta

Stalkers: Dance d'Oro, Mon Petit Chou, Pacific Gale

Closers: Family Time, Crumb Bun, Starship Nala

This one will be fairly fast up front. Most 7-furlong sprints produce a pretty wicked pace, and four pretty fast horses are entered here. Being mid-pack is probably where you want to be here.

TOP CHOICE: #5 FOUR GRACES

This horse runs second off of the layoff here, which should lead to improvement after nearly winning an allowance race last time out. She is comfortable at this class level, while her best effort might just be a small bit better than the rest of this field. All four of her victories have also come at this 7-furlong distance.

MAJOR THREATS: #3 Dance d'Oro, #6 Pacific Gale, #7 Jakarta, #8 Just One Time

Dance d'Oro has won two of her last three starts, but the waters get deeper today, which is going to be a question mark. Pacific Gale can repeat here if the pace sets up perfectly. Jakarta won over the dirt last time out at Parx in upset fashion. Just One Time debuts for the Cox barn today after dominating weaker horses at Penn National.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 A G Indy

A G Indy moves over to the dirt for this race after winning three of four on the turf. If she takes to the turf she will be tough, while you can expect she will be on the lead in this spot as well. The presence of so much other speed is what's a bit troubling, but she's shown a lot of class.

OTHERS: #1 Family Time, #4 Mon Petit Chou, #9 Crumb Bun, #10 Starship Nala

These horses usually fit in well in a race like this; however, this year's race turned out to be very tough. They'll be hard-pressed to make an impact here.

RACE No. 9:

PEGASUS WORLD CUP Filly & Mare TURF (G3)

1 1/16 MILES (TURF)
Fillies & Mares
4-Year-Olds & Upward
\$500,000

OVERVIEW:

For the first time ever, we have a Pegasus World Cup Filly and Mare Turf, which is a welcomed addition to the race card. The initial running drew a solid field of 11, with several of the major turf trainers sending horses to run, including the favored Regal Glory for trainer Chad Brown.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: Lady Speightspeare, Shifty She

Pressing Speed: Sweet Melania, Regal Glory, In a Hurry

Stalkers: Wakanaka, Alms, Nicest

Closers: Gift List, Summer in Saratoga, Bipartisanship

This is another turf race that should have a decent pace. A few main contenders have early speed, but the stalkers can turn it up a notch early if needed.

TOP CHOICE: #4 REGAL GLORY

The classiest horse in the race, she always shows up with a strong effort. She is also pretty versatile as well, winning from on the lead and coming from off of the pace. She comes into this race after winning the Matriarch Stakes (G1) at Del Mar, and it is never a bad thing to have Chad Brown on your side on the turf.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Sweet Melania, #2 Wakanaka, #3 Lady Speightspeare, #9 Shifty She

Sweet Melania and Shifty She ran 1-2 in the in the Swanee River Stakes (G3) last time out and should be tough again today. Look for Lady Speightspeare to bounce back from her first defeat last time out. Wakanaka is very interesting, debuting in the United States for Bill Mott after winning several races in Italy.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #5 Gift List, #6 Alms

Gift List has hit the board in three straight stakes efforts since arriving in the United States, including a victory in the Edgewood Stakes (G2) at Churchill Downs last time out. Alms should bounce back and run better today after a non-effort last time out. She can win at a price if she does bounce back.

OTHERS: #7 Nicest, #8 Summer in Saratoga, #10 In a Hurry, #11 Bipartisanship

This race is pretty wide-open, making it hard to throw anyone out, but this group looks like they need to improve quite a bit to have a shot here.

FRED W. HOOPER STAKES (G3)

1 MILE (DIRT)
4-Year-Olds & Upward
\$150,000

OVERVIEW:

This race usually gives us some excitement as the dirt males go a mile in this spot. The field here looks to be fun, and we should see some fireworks. Several of these horses were probably good enough to compete in normal runnings of the Pegasus World Cup, but avoided it this year due to the heavy hitters entered there.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Liam, Speaker's Corner*

Pressing Speed: *Dennis' Moment*

Stalkers: *Fearless, Payne, Bon Raison, Officiating*

Closers: *Shivaree, Girolamo's Attack*

There are few fast ones in this spot, but none that really have to have the lead. So you can expect them to be running decent up front, but nothing to the point that should cause a meltdown.

TOP CHOICE: #8 SPEAKER'S CORNER

If you draw a line through his Pennsylvania Derby (G1) effort, this horse has never run a bad race. Since that loss, he has dominated allowance company, before a hard fought second place finish in the Discovery Stakes, which saw him lose narrowly to Miles D. Today, he should be able to sit just outside all the speed, and pounce at the top of the lane. The cut back in distance will also help.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Fearless, #6 Liam

Fearless was able to capture the Harlan's Holiday Stakes (G3) last time out, which shows that he is back in solid form for this race. Liam came back victorious after a long layoff last time out, and can win this race if he improves off of that effort.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Officiating

We'll see if this guy can pull off two upsets in a row after winning the local prep race for this one last time out. His solid form gives him a shot, but he still must improve from a speed figure standpoint, as the waters will get deeper in this spot today.

OTHERS: #2 Payne, #3 Bon Raison, #5 Shivaree, #7 Dennis' Moment, #9 Girolamo's Attack

This really seems like a two-horse race, so everyone else in this spot looks overmatched. Anyone winning from this group would be shocking.

\$1,000,000

OVERVIEW:

The Pegasus World Cup Turf provides us with a nice betting affair once again this year, with a dozen evenly-matched horses lining up to run. Defending champion Colonel Liam is back today; however, we have not seen him race since June of 2021. That gives us cause for concern and a reason to play against.

At 12-1, he's worth a play in this spot, especially with the favorite coming off of a long layoff.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Hit the Road, #6 Colonel Liam, #7 Doswell, #8 Sacred Life

Hit the Road has been classy on the California circuit, and should be able to compete in this spot. Colonel Liam will look to make it two in a row in this race, but is back off of a long layoff today. Doswell impressively won the local prep for this one. Sacred Life was a tough luck loser last time out for Chad Brown.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #9 Field Pass, #12 Never Surprised

Field Pass won the Seabiscuit Handicap (G2) at Del Mar last time out in impressive fashion with a smart ride by Rispoli, who rides him again today. Never Surprised has a big shot here; however, the far outside draw will do him no favors.

It was really tough to go against Knicks Go here after he completely saved us at the Breeders Cup. We didn't get much right on that Saturday, but we played him hard, and he got us paid. Stilleto Boy has been fairly competitive against top level competition and has a good shot to hit the board at a big price.

Chess Chief skipped a stakes at Fair Grounds (the only track he's won at) in favor of this spot, so expect him to run a pretty solid race. Sir Winston comes into this one in great form, but those races were over the synthetic surface at Woodbine.
