

It's time for the main event! The Breeders' Cup is finally here and the Dudes are ready to go! This year, we're going to once again give you the **EXACT** race-by-race wagering plan of Aaron and Jared, who will be betting LIVE at the Breeders' Cup throughout the two days. You can play these tickets exactly, or you can take our opinions and sprinkle in your own thoughts as well. The decision is up to you. Ultimately, we shot for an approximate \$600 budget.

Let's not waste any more time. Here's our wagering plan for all 14 of this year's Breeders' Cup races:

DAY 1

Friday Race #6: JUVENILE TURF SPRINT

We'll keep it simple to start this thing off with a win wager on #2 Love Reigns. She'll be tough in here; however, we aren't quite as confident as we were in years past with horses like Golden Pal, so we'll keep the win amount a tad lower.

We'll look to play a Daily Double in this race as we couldn't settle on a straight bet wager. We both like #4 Free Look on top, then we get a little different underneath. So, we'll play a double with her, as well as #7 Spirit Gal and #9 Delight into Cave Rock in the next race.

Friday Race #9: JUVENILE

This is our strongest opinion of the Breeders' Cup, so we will keep it simple and pound #3 Cave Rock in this spot with a large win wager. He looks to tower over this group no matter how you look at it. Hopefully, we also have a nice Daily Double alive to him in this spot from the last race.

Friday Race #10: JUVENILE TURF

The theme of Friday at The Breeders' Cup seems to be "keep it simple." We both love the #4 Silver Knott in this race, so it only seems logical to keep the win bets rolling. We believe his price will good enough to through a sizable win wager on him.

We also fell in love with the replays on the #1 Victoria Road. So, we'll play a small exacta back with him and Silver Knott as well in this spot.

To kick off the Saturday action we'll go with a trifecta box, looking to hit a home run early on in the card. Jared believes #4 Ce Ce can repeat, and I like #7 Obligatory on top. We'll put them in the box, while also throwing in #8 Goodnight Olive and #13 Echo Zulu.


Saturday Race #5: DIRT MILE

We're all over the place in this one, which seems like the most wide-open event of the Breeders' Cup. Instead of getting crazy with a trifecta bet, we decided to use both of our top choices to start what he hope is a massive pick 3. We'll use #5 Pipeline and #9 Cyberknife in this leg, while using the #9 Rougir and #11 In Italian in leg two, with the heavily favorite #9 Jackie's Warrior in the last leg.

Saturday Race #6: FILLY & MARE TURF

This absolutely could be the race of the weekend! Several superstars are signed on to run here, so make sure you don't miss this contest. In the end, we believe #9 Rougir and #11 In Italian are the two who stand out most. We've had tremendous success with big turf exactas in our past wagering guides, so we'll implore that strategy in this spot with the two Chad Brown runners!

Saturday Race #7: SPRINT

#9 Jackie's Warrior looks like the horse to beat once again this year; however, he did not get the job done last season. Still, we love the pace set up he gets today, while the race of this field leaves a lot to be desired. His price will be short, though, so you can't really bet him to win. Instead, we will single him to start off a \$20 pick 3. In the next leg we'll use #4 Modern Games and #3 Dreamloper, and then we will single #6 Nest in the last leg.

Saturday Race #8: MILE

Last year, we loved Modern Games, and this year we love him again. Hopefully we get paid this season, unlike last year where he ended up running for purse money only. We'll keep this race simple and just bet him with a healthy win wager.

Saturday Race #11: CLASSIC

It's the race of the year, for Horse of the Year, and we couldn't be more excited. From a betting standpoint, the first decision is whether to play Flightline or try to beat him. We've decided to play him because we think he might be one of the best horses we've ever seen from a talent prospective. In fact, we're going to hammer #4 Flightline in this spot in a straight exacta with #1 Taiba. We'd love to bet Flightline to win, but the price isn't going to be there, so you've got to couple him up with a horse to put in second. #1 Taiba will offer some value in the second spot, and should be ready to run the best race of his career on the biggest day. Let's see if we can get him home, and let's also see if Flightline can put on a show for us this weekend!

BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE TURF SPRINT (G2)

OVERVIEW:

This event kicks off the Breeders' Cup action on Friday. For the fifth straight year, it drew a full field, which makes the race a success when compared to the now-defunct Juvenile Dirt Sprint. Trainer Wesley Ward will aim to win this race for the 4th straight season.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Speed Boat Beach, Tyler's Tribe, Sharp Aza Tack, Oxyomore*

Pressing Speed: *Love Reigns, The Platinum Queen*

Stalkers: *American Apple, Lady Hollywood*

Closers: *Dramatised, Mischief Magic, Persian Force, Private Creed*

Expect a swift pace here, as 3 horses entered will all want to go early. Settling just off the lead is going to be important this year.

TOP CHOICE: #2 LOVE REIGNS

Wesley Ward has been tremendous in this race, winning it 3 straight seasons, and he has the top choice heading into this year's event with Love Reigns leading the charge. She scratched out of a recent race at Keeneland with Ward saying he didn't want to "waste" her best effort on the race before the big event. She seems locked and loaded for a prime effort in this spot.

MAJOR THREATS: #3 Private Creed, #5 Mischief Magic, #7 Oxyomore, #12 The Platinum Queen

Private Creed will be flying from the back and will benefit from a hot pace. Mischief Magic is another overseas runner with a solid resume. Oxyomore should benefit from cutting back in distance. The Platinum Queen has been sensational overseas, even defeating older horses in her last start.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #10 Tyler's Tribe, #11 Speed Boat Beach

Tyler's Tribe has an incredible turn of foot early; however, he will be making his turf debut after a poor workout over this course leading up to the race. Speed Boat Beach was sensational in his dirt debut but didn't look quite as fast when running (and still winning) over the turf.

OTHERS: #1 Lady Hollywood, #4 Dramatised, #6 Persian Force, #8 American Apple, #9 Sharp Aza Tack

This race got a little tricky with the post position draws, so an upset is possible and means you can't toss aside many of these. A horse from this group could surprise; however, we just prefer others a bit more in this spot.

NETJETS BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE FILLIES (G1)

OVERVIEW:

This race seems to be wide-open this season after a favorite dominated the race last year. The favorite will likely be around 4/1, which makes this one of the most attractive betting events of the entire Breeders' Cup.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Grand Love, Wonder Wheel*

Pressing Speed: *Atomically, Chocolate Gelato*

Stalkers: *And Tell Me Nolies, Leave No Trace, Raging Sea, You're My Girl, Alma Rosa*

Closers: *American Rockette, Chop Chop, Shoplifter, Sabra Tuff, Vegas Magic*

In a full field like this, you can usually count on a fast pace, with this spot being no different. The closers should have a fair shot in this one.

TOP CHOICE: #7 CHOP CHOP

This Brad Cox trainee ran pretty well in her debut effort over the turf last time out, running a close second in the Darley Alcibiades Stakes (G1) after making a strong close kick. The filly should improve in her second start over the dirt today, while the pace should be plenty fast enough for her in this spot. She looms dangerous if she gets a clean trip this time around.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Wonder Wheel, #8 Atomically, #10 Chocolate Gelato, #14 Raging Sea

Chocolate Gelato is the deserving favorite after 2 solid scores on the NYRA circuit. Atomically looks to keep her streak going under new trainer Todd Pletcher. Wonder Wheel won the local prep for this race in gate to wire fashion. Raging Sea comes into the race well but drew a horrible post - a common theme for Chad Brown this weekend.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #9 Grand Love

This Steve Asmussen trainee is interesting in this spot after an impressive debut at Saratoga. Last time out, she stretched out for the first time, finishing third in a Churchill Downs stakes. If she improves stretching out for the second time, then she could be tough here at a price.

OTHERS: #1 Vegas Magic, #2 You're My Girl, #3 And Tell Me Nolies, #4 Sabra Tuff, #6 Alma Rose, #11 American Rockette, #12 Shoplifter, #13 Leave No Trace

This is another race that seems pretty wide open. Any of these from this group can jump up and pull off an upset with some improvement. We just prefer other horses a bit more in this spot.

OVERVIEW:

American horses have kept the Euros from winning this race in most years, but some tough runners shipped over to contest it this season. Will the trend continue?

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Delight, Pleasant Passage*

Pressing Speed: *Basil Martini, Free Look, Xigera*

Stalkers: *Be Your Best, Meditate, Spirit Gal*

Closers: *Cairo Consort, Comanche Country, G Laurie, Last Call, Midnight Mile, Manhattan Jungle*

We won't see a pace meltdown in this spot; however, it should be a decent tempo up front. With turf races, you can always count on it being a little slower up front.

TOP CHOICE: #4 FREE LOOK

Let's take a shot with this Chad Brown runner at a decent price in this spot. Brown has been great in this race over the years and this filly probably lost last time because of a yielding track last time out at Belmont at the Big A. With a fast track, coupled with a hot pace up front, she should be set up to run her best race on the biggest stage.

MAJOR THREATS: #9 Delight, #10 Meditate, #12 Midnight Mile, #13 Xigera

Delight won the local prep for this race in ultra-impressive fashion. Meditate is probably the best European runner in the race, boasting back-to-back runner-up efforts in Group 1 company. Midnight Mile won 2 straight races overseas including a Group 3 race last time out. Xigera gets back to the turf today, which is her best surface.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #7 Spirit Gal, #14 Basil Martini

Spirit Gal also bring European class to the race. She won 2 straight races coming into this including a stakes event last time out. Basil Martini ships in from overseas for Aidan O'Brien with a big shot after some solid efforts.

OTHERS: #1 Comanche Country, #2 Cairo Consort, #3 Last Call, #5 Pleasant Passage, #6 Be Your Best, #8 Manhattan Jungle, #11 G Laurie

We'll look to get a few prices involved in this race, including our top choice, so some of these other prices will be left off the ticket. However, if you like one of these, then don't let us talk you off of them, as this seems to be a wide-open event.

FANDUEL BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE (G1)

OVERVIEW:

We'll see who takes the first major step towards the 2022 Kentucky Derby in this race, and this field is one of the best that we've seen in several runnings. The winner will most likely be the 2-Year-Old Male of the Year and the race could produce several Derby starters.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: Cave Rock

Pressing Speed: Hurricane J

Stalkers: Forte, National Treasure, Verifying, Congruent

Closers: Blazing Sevens, Curly Jack, Lost Ark, Wound Up

Usually, you see a strong pace contested in the Juvenile; however, I don't think we'll see it this season. Cave Rock should take this field gate to wire while being able to dictate the early fractions.

TOP CHOICE: #3 CAVE ROCK

This could be the next big superstar out of the Bob Baffert barn. He comes into the race with a perfect record including back-to-back Grade 1 scores in impressive fashion. To make matter worse for the competition today, he looks like he could be alone on the lead, which will make him even tougher to beat. Baffert says this horse reminds him of American Pharoah, which is a great sign.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 Forte, #6 Blazing Sevens, #10 National Treasure

Forte won the local prep race for this and seems to be getting better with each start. Blazing Sevens closed fast from way out of it take home the Champagne Stakes in his last start. National Treasure was a distant second behind our top choice last time out in the American Pharoah Stakes at Santa Anita.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #9 Curly Jack

This son of Good Magic improved greatly when stretching out in distance last time out, winning the Iroquois Stakes in impressive fashion. That sort of improvement makes him interesting in this spot.

OTHERS: #1 Hurricane J, #2 Congruent, #5 Verifying, #7 Wound Up, #8 Lost Ark

This one looks pretty top-heavy, which makes these runners look a bit out-classed in this spot. Any of these winning would be a major surprise.

OVERVIEW:

This event has been dominated by Europeans in the past and another strong contingent has shipped in for this year's running. However, the American turf juveniles also look strong this year, which should make for an ultra-competitive contest.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: Gaslight Dancer, Major Dude, Curly Larry and Mo

Pressing Speed: Nagirroc, Packs a Wallop

Stalkers: Silver Knott, Victoria Road, Mo Stash

Closers: Andthefwinneris, Battle of Normandy, I'm Very Busy, Really Good, Reckoning Force, Webslinger

This is another turf pace that shouldn't be overly fast; however, enough speed horses are in here that should make things honest. Everyone should have a fair shot.

TOP CHOICE: #4 SILVER KNOTT

It's another year and we have another superstar horse in the Juvenile Turf from trainer Charlie Appleby. Last year, he brought over Modern Games, who dominated for an easy victory. Silver Knott is his latest star juvenile to give it a try and should be formidable if he shows up with the same effort that he showed in his last start. His race replays jump out significantly when compared to the rest of these runners.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Victoria Road, #6 Andthefwinneris, #8 I'm Very Busy, #13 Major Dude

Victoria Road ships in from overseas after 3 straight wins coming in impressive fashion. Andthefwinneris won the local prep race for this. Major Dude and I'm Very Busy were solid 1-2 finishers of the Pilgrim Stakes last time out at Belmont Park.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #2 Packs a Wahlop

Usually, California turf horses don't do well in these types of race; however, Packs a Wahlop could buck that trend this year. He won 3 straight with ease since moving to the turf, including a pair of Grade 3 victories at Santa Anita and Del Mar. He shows up here with a ton of momentum.

OTHERS: #3 Curly Larry and Mo, #5 Battle of Normandy, #7 Really Good, #9 Nagirroc, #10 Webslinger, #11 Reckoning Force, #12 Mo Stash, #14 Gaslight Dancer

This race got a little tricky with the post position draws, so an upset is possible, which means you can't toss aside many of these. A horse from this group could surprise.

BETTING CHALLENGE

Key Plays

I love multi-race sequences. I love big scores. And I love the Breeders' Cup for both of those reasons.

There are a select few days a year when you know you have a shot to clear \$100,000 if you're right, and the Breeders' Cup gives you back-to-back days. For the first time, it will be that way in the tournament world as well.

Before I dive into some strategy, let's talk about why it's worth playing. Imagine a bet with 10% takeout, where you could lose 10 of the 12 races and still win \$15,000. Welcome to Win / Place tournaments.

The Breeders' Cup is an amazing weekend to play these, with prices abound and the bankroll it could cost to try to really slam the Pick 5s or the Pick 6.

WIN / PLACE TOURNAMENT STRATEGY

There are two styles of Win / Place tournaments available: Live, where you can change your pick anytime before the horses break from the gate, and Pick & Pray, where you have to select all races before the first contest race starts. Live tournament strategy (especially later in the event) can vary based on where you're placed, so because of that, I'm going to focus on the Pick & Pray Breeders' Cup strategy.

1. Don't play the "can't lose" favorites

I'm looking at you, Golden Pal, Cave Rock, and Flightline. All will be odds-on and cost you more to play than to play against in a tournament setting. You don't need to pick the winner of every race to win, you just need the highest total from Win and Place cashes.

That's 14 bullets to fire, 1 for each Breeders' Cup race.

If you use a bullet on Flightline, who will most likely win, then your maximum upside is \$3 over the second-place horse (Your Win + Place payout vs. their Place payout). However, if you play Flightline and he loses, not only did you lose one of your 14 bets, you will also be behind a minimum of \$15 since everyone else will be at least 4/1 in the race. The opportunity cost is too great.

Additionally, if you're behind, short prices leave you drawing dead to make up the ground needed to win. Don't play anything less than 4/1.

2. Don't play the "obvious" long shot

Every year, horses get hyped coming into Breeders' Cup weekend who are a juicy 10/1 or 15/1 on the morning line. I generally try to avoid those horses when playing Pick & Pray tournaments.

The first issue is they will be heavily used and won't offer nearly as much value as the morning line projects. If you're in a tournament with 100 people and 30 people have a 10/1 shot, then the other long shots in the race (and even the 5/1 types) have massive value. In the Juvenile Fillies, the Pletcher trainee Atomically comes to mind. She will be heavily used in tournaments.

Another major issue is that these horses often get bet down. One extremely valuable skill in tournaments is understanding when a morning line is incorrect. Since you're trying to go price hunting, using a 12/1 that goes off at 3/1 is not ideal, especially when the horse is overused in a Pick & Pray.

BCBC

One of the most prestigious tournaments of the year is the Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge - the BCBC - and it's not for the faint of heart. You buy in for \$10,000 and start with a \$7,500 bankroll that you'll have to turn into \$150,000, an approximation of what it takes to win. That means you'll be all-in AT LEAST once if you want the \$300,000 top prize.

1. Hammering cold exactas / doubles makes big moves

Rarely am I running to the window to bet \$5,000 to win on an 8/1 prop, but you can find those types of exactas and doubles at the Breeder's Cup. In fact, I bet this year's winner of the BCBC hits a massive cold exacta in the final race, the Classic. While Flightline is your likely winner, you have 3 logical options underneath that will split up the exacta pool and create some value on any cold exacta.

Due to the field sizes, the daily doubles can be great plays as well. Modern Games looks even stronger after the draw, with both main competitors platooned in the 13 and 14 posts, but due to the sheer number of horses in the Mile, playing a double into or out of Modern Games should be a good proposition, especially if you're trying to beat Jackie's Warrior or Nest.

2. Be aggressive

While the adage "You can't win the tournament on Day 1" is true, you sure can set yourself up well. The final 2 races are extremely important in live bankroll tournaments, but rarely will they be your biggest opinions.

If you love something on Friday, don't be afraid to go broke. You must turn \$7,500 into \$150,000 to win the tournament, and that takes being right multiple times.

The same goes for the under card. Don't be afraid to fire away, even when it doesn't count toward your minimum bets. Last year, Lone Rock was one of the best bets at 7/5 all weekend and a great spot to more than double up early on Saturday's card.

Now, \$7,500 is a lot of money to be betting, so many of you may ask why this is relevant. One of my favorite ways to play the ponies - and a great way to teach yourself how to maximize your return - is to play live bankroll tournaments.

You can play your own version of the BCBC with a bankroll of \$750 or even \$75 (just do the math to make sure you're playing correctly within the rules). It's amazing how you can press \$75 into \$1,000 in a day if you get extremely strategic about your approach and have a little luck! Try it out and see where you would have ended up on the leaderboard.

TOP CHOICE: #7 OBLIGATORY

The pace in this race seems like it is going to be "mind-melting fast" and that should benefit this horse the most. She's a consistent runner that always shows up with a solid effort and she should get all the pace in the world to run at down the stretch. At 8/1, she's worth a play in this spot. She should make things interesting if she gets a decent trip.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Edgeway,
#8 Goodnight Olive, #13 Echo Zulu

Edgeway is a consistent runner who comes in this race off of an impressive victory at Del Mar. Goodnight Olive has been flawless for Chad Brown in 3 starts this season, including a Grade 1 victory last time out. Echo Zulu has the class but is breaking from a tough post position.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #5 Frank's Rockette

She comes into this race off of 2 impressive races, including a nice win last time out at Churchill Downs. The problem is, she has trouble finishing the job and finishing her races with a win, but she is ultra-consistent and can definitely hit the board in this spot with a top effort.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #9 Naval Crown

Naval Crown has the right connections on his side to win at a big price. He has been poor in his last three starts, though, which is the big worry coming into this spot. Look from him to run an improved race today and is worth a look if the price stays high.

This group looks to be a little overmatched in this spot. If the pace sets up as expected, then Three Technique might benefit enough to pick up some pieces, but he probably can't win the race.

This one look like it could be fairly slow up front, with only 2 real speed horses signed on to run. We could see an interesting dynamic in this race.

TOP CHOICE: #4 MODERN GAMES

Modern Games is back at the Breeders' Cup after winning the Juvenile Turf last season at Del Mar. He's had another solid season this year and his earlier trip to North American was a dominant score in the Woodbine Mile. If he brings that kind of effort to this race, then he'll be tough to beat.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Pogo, #3 Dreamloper, #11 Annapolis, #13 Kinross

Pogo goes for 2 straight in this spot after winning a Group 2 event last time out. Dreamloper comes into this off of an ultra-impressive victory over Group 1 company last time out. Annapolis seems to be the best American hope to win this race. Kinross' replays jump off the screen at you, but he drew a poor post today.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #8 Regal Glory

At one time, she looked like the best miler in the country, but back to back losses have us questioning her chances in this spot. She is 6/1 on the morning line; however, she should float up from that number. If she gets to double digits, then she might be worth a small play, but not at her current price.

OTHERS: #2 Shirl's Speight, #5 Smooth Like Strait, #6 Ivar, #7 Beyond Brilliant, #9 Malavath, #10 Order of Australia, #12 King Cause, #14 Domestic Spending

There are some really good horses in this race who could make an impact, but we just prefer a few others. This is a loaded race from top to bottom.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Society*

Pressing Speed: *Blue Stripe, Search Results*

Stalkers: *Nest, Awake At Midnyte*

Closers: *Clairiere, Malathaat, Secret Oath*

Society looks like the only true speed horse in here, which makes her dangerous. Search Results and Blue Stripe could push her, but you shouldn't expect a fast pace.

TOP CHOICE: #6 NEST

Let's see if this 3-year-old filly can cap off a tremendous second half of the season with a win in this spot. She has won 3 straight stakes races with ease, including 2 Grade 1 scores in dominant fashion at Saratoga over the summer. She also could have won the Belmont Stakes against the males earlier in the year with a better trip. Simply put, she has become a superstar this season.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Malathaat, #4 Clairiere

Malathaat has turned into a better horse with each start this season and comes into this race in perfect form. Clairiere can win if she rebounds from a poor effort last time out.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #8 Society

They say pace makes the race, and that makes Society dangerous in this spot. There is no doubt that she's the fastest horse early and could clear this field with a solid break from this outside post. Keeneland tends to favor speed, which might make her dangerous in this spot.

OTHERS: #2 Blue Stripe, #3 Secret Oath, #5 Awake At Midnyte, #7 Search Results

This group looks to be filler in what is shaping up to be a classic battle between the top few. We could see something special, just maybe not so much from these.

Stalkers: *Channel Maker, Mishriff, Nations Pride*

Closers: *Broome, Gold Phoenix, Master Piece, Nautilus, Rebel's Romance, Red Knight, Stone Age, War Like Goddess*

Most longer turf races in this country have a slow pace, and this one looks to be no different. They'll crawl early, and then fly home late.

TOP CHOICE: #5 REBEL'S ROMANCE

Charlie Appleby brought over a tremendous group of runner for this year's Breeders' Cup and Rebel's Romance is perhaps the best of the group. He won 4 straight races this season, including back-to-back victories against tougher Group 1 company in his last 2 starts. This will be a major test for him, but he's likely defeated tougher runners than these already this season.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 War Like Goddess, #4 Broome, #7 Nations Pride

War Like Goddess is the best United States runner in the race and should be tough to hold off in the stretch. Nations Pride is an excellent international runner with plenty of United States experience. Broome comes to the United States for Aidan O'Brien with a big chances to pull the upset.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #3 Stone Age, #11 Mishriff

Stone Age could jump up and win this one with his best effort. Mishriff is the class of the field, having won Group 1 stakes all over the world. However, are his better days behind him? He has not looked like the same horse in his last few starts.

OTHERS: #1 Bye Bye Melvin, #6 Channel Maker, #8 Master Piece, #9 Gold Phoenix, #10 Red Knight, #12 Nautilus, #13 Highland Chief

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Life Is Good*

Pressing Speed: *Flightline, Hot Rod Charlie*

Stalkers: *Taiba, Epicenter*

Closers: *Olympiad, Rich Strike, Happy Saver*

Any time you get Life Is Good in the race, you know the pace will be fast, so expect some pretty quick fractions in this one as well. You want to be close to the lead over this track, though, no matter how fast they go early.

TOP CHOICE: #4 FLIGHTLINE

Simply put, he was a total freak in his Pacific Classic romp. If he shows up with that kind of effort again at the Breeders' Cup, there isn't another horse in the field good enough to challenge him. The level of competition he faced in the Pacific Classic is questionable, but he totally ran away from that group. Look for him to take a couple of challenges in this spot, but overall, he just looks to be better than anyone else.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Taiba, #2 Life Is Good, #6 Epicenter

Taiba has been steadily improving since returning from his Kentucky Derby disaster and is ready to put up his best effort yet. Life Is Good is who they'll all have to catch on the front end. Epicenter has turned into a monster this season and will be ready to put up another top effort in this spot.

LONG SHOTS TO USE: #5 Hot Rod Charlie

The super consistent Hot Rod Charlie will try to once again hit the board in a big race at a solid price. He has some trouble winning races, but this horse always shows up with a solid effort. He'll run his race, and it won't be good enough to win, but it might be good enough to spice up the exotics.

OTHERS: #3 Happy Saver, #7 Olympiad, #8 Rich Strike

It's hard to see any of these being able to make much of an impact against such a top-heavy group. If the pace melts down, it's possible one of these could hit the board, but we prefer others a big more.

PLAYS

Back in 2015, when I met the Racing Dudes at Saratoga for the first time and began discussing ways to work with them, I pitched the idea to develop a "Guide" for betting the 2015 Breeders' Cup, the first one ever held at Keeneland.

Seven years and hundreds of guides later, I'm back at it with this Guide article for the third Breeders' Cup (BC) held at Keeneland. We've learned enough from past runnings here to know how to spot value throughout the cards.

MAKING VALUE WITH A SUPER HORSE

In 2015, a super horse and Triple Crown winner was the odds-on 7/10 favorite in the Classic. Leveraging the great American Pharoah as a single at the end of sequences would've netted you a 50-cent Pick 4 payout of \$765 if you were able to connect Tepin, Nyquist, and Found in the previous 3 races. The \$2 Pick 3 ending in Pharoah paid a handsome \$453.

The moral of the story: "You can make money with an odds-on favorite on BC day. You just gotta be right!"

There's value everywhere on BC day with the big pools and champion-caliber horses available at 5/1 odds or higher. I'm not trying to blindly give you crazy long shots - it's about leveraging your strongest opinions into your wagering strategy to create Value with your bets.

My strongest opinion at this year's BC:

Flightline will win the Breeders Cup Classic.

Thanks Slim, tell me something I don't know! Well, what you may not be doing is ending every pool you can get your hands on with Flightline as a single. Even if that's obvious, how do you structure your wagers within your budget to make that a lucrative process?

My overall budget for this Breeders' Cup article is \$200, and I'm willing to wager half of that on bets with Flightline in the top spot. Why not just bet \$100 to win on Flightline? Well, if he's 2/5, then I'll only make \$20 off of my strongest opinion. I need to connect a few legs here to give it more value. My goal is to be alive to Flightline for as much as possible on Saturday night.

I'll focus on Pick 3s and Doubles with Flightline in the payoff leg. There are plenty of great Pick 4 and 5 tickets to play in the rest of this Guide, so go check those out after getting my opinions here. For my purposes, I'm going to pound town with my \$100 budget on less complex tickets.

Starting with the Distaff, there are two ways to go:

1. Play for a slower pace that will favor early leaders like Society, Search Results, and Nest, or
2. Hope for enough pace to get Malathaath and Clairiere up for the win.

I'll side with Scenario #2 above and play the horses that can come from off of the pace: Malathaath and Clairiere, who have battled each other 2 years in a row at the highest levels. I stood 20 feet away at the beginning of this year's Personal Ensign when Clairiere hit her head twice on the gate, cutting her tongue in the process, so I give her an excuse for her last effort.

I'm weary to play pace meltdowns when speed has been so good at the current Keeneland meet (50% of 9-furlong dirt races wired so far in the meet), but with Society, Awake At Midnite, and Search Results all ensuring swift early fractions, it sets up for the older female class of the race. I'm trying to beat Nest (maybe foolishly) in the first leg of this Pick 3, as I don't think she's met this level of class in her career yet.

The next leg is the Turf and there are a lot of Europeans I'm interested in playing. With plenty of speed signed on, it can set up for the Euros to close into yet another victory.

I'm playing the two Aidan O'Briens, the two Charlie Applebys, and the John Gosden trainee. Appleby and Gosden have won this race 2 of the past 4 years, while Aidan will look for his seventh career win in the BC Turf.

I do love War Like Goddess, but I also think it's going to be very difficult for her to beat all five Euros in this spot. My 2 x 5 x 1 Pick 3 for \$4 is shown below:

I have \$60 left in my original Flightline single budget, so next I will play \$8 Doubles to Flightline with my Turf selections, as shown below:

I absolutely love to see Irad Ortiz Jr. get back on Broome, as Broome was able to hold on for second last year in this race with Irad aboard. Stone Age can show speed early, so I'm hoping to get a price with one of the Aidan entries or the classy Mishriff. I'll be checking the double probables and will likely need to pound any low payouts from the two Appleby trainees into Flightline to balance my payouts.

Looking at the Classic by itself, I'll get creative and play a straight wager with Epicenter and Olympiad filling out second and third under Flightline. I don't like that Taiba drew the rail, as he isn't a horse that excels inside of horses, and it may be to his detriment eventually having to get around Epicenter. Olympiad feels like the overlooked horse in this race that will be the contrarian play to make this trifecta pay. He's a grinder and at this distance, he may just stay the trip for third, if he doesn't try to get confrontational looking a horse in the eye, especially Flightline. My 2022 Classic trifecta is below:

EARLY SATURDAY VALUE

I'm looking to get ahead for the day early and will use my remaining \$100 budget for early bets on the card, starting with a salty Filly & Mare Sprint. I said earlier I am worried about playing pace meltdowns on a speed-favoring track, but I have no clue how this one doesn't fall apart. This race has had some crazy paces in the last few years that set up for closers, and I like 2 horses to take advantage in 2022: Goodnight Olive and Obligatory. Goodnight Olive looked super-impressive beating Obligatory in the Ballerina last out. Obligatory has done her best running in Kentucky at 7 furlongs and she'll love running late into this blazing pace. I really like these 2 in this spot and expect decent exacta odds, so a \$10 exacta box should provide some nice value:

The next race has a heavy favorite that I'll lean on. Keeneland turf horse for course is an angle I'll be relying on all BC weekend, as the turf there suits some but not all. Golden Pal is a perfect 4 for 4 at Keeneland and looks to repeat in the Turf Sprint. Early speed usually wins this race and Golden Pal should wire this field.

The Dirt Mile is another race with a ton of pace signed on. I really like Cyberknife to sit the trip in this one. Gunite has been one of my favorite horses all season with his gutty performances, but I do have some worries about his distance limitations while hoping he stays out of an early pace chase. I'll play against Cody's Wish as the favorite, trying to get some value on this ticket. I'll play a heavy 2 x 1 x 2 Pick 3 for \$10 as follows:

With Golden Pal a likely heavy favorite, I have to go to pound town here to get value and I'm willing to put 40% of my \$100 non-Flightline budget on this bet.

I have \$40 left, so I'm going to play another Pick 3. This article is about creating value and I think the Pick 3 is an under-utilized bet on BC day. Use a higher denomination to press your strongest opinions!

I'll start this one with the Filly & Mare Turf, with another pace play and a horse that won last out over the Keeneland turf: In Italian. She looks like lone speed on paper and Chad Brown likes to win this race with 4 wins in the past 10 years. Still, 2 Europeans coming over out of the same race may be really tough for In Italian to hold off. Nashwa did all the dirty work on the front-end of her last Group 1 to barely hold on for second to Above the Curve for Joseph O'Brien, who won this race in 2019. These 2 Euros are must-uses.

The Sprint looks like Jackie's Warrior will have a pace advantage. He has the heart of a champion and I don't think he lets any of these other horses get by him in a gate-to-wire triumph to end his storied career.

On the other hand, the Mile looks like a wide-open affair, so I'll look to spread with 4 horses here. From the US contingent keeping with my Keeneland horse for turf course angle, I have to use Annapolis, as he won impressively against elders last out in a Grade 1 over this sod.

From the Europeans squad, I have to use Order of Australia, as he won this exact race only two years ago at Keeneland and Aidan O'Brien himself told me in July he was pointing this horse to this race. Obviously, I can't get beat by likely favorite Modern Games for Appleby, but I believe others can win this race, so I hope to get a price. Kinross is riding a 4-race win streak in Group 1 and 2 stakes and has to be on the ticket here:
