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INSIDE TRACK

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This **Inside Track to the Risen Star** wagering guide gives you an inside look at the **six stakes** races running at Fair Grounds Race Course on February 18, 2023, including the \$400,000 Risen Star Stakes (G2). The 1 1/8-mile race is worth 50-20-15-10-5 points to the top 5 finishers on the 2023 Road to the Kentucky Derby (G1).

The Racing Dudes have been at it for 10+ years, offering daily handicapping picks and analysis for every track across the country. For this year's **Inside Track to the Risen Star**, our lead handicappers have been scouring through the card at Fair Grounds in search of winning tickets on this loaded day of racing.

The six stakes races total \$1.3 million in purses and include both Kentucky Derby and Kentucky Oaks (G1) prep races: the Risen Star, the \$300,000 Rachel Alexandra (G2) for the Oaks, the \$250,000 Mineshaft (G3), the \$150,000 Fair Grounds (G3), the \$100,000 Albert M. Stall Memorial, and the \$100,000 Colonel Power.

But that's not all! Along with the six major stakes races, this Inside Track to the Risen Star wagering guide also includes race-by-race analysis, betting suggestions, and multi-race plays for Fair Ground's entire Saturday card.

For each of the **six stakes** at Fair Grounds, you will find the following:

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RACE No. 6:

ALBERT M. STALL MEMORIAL STAKES

ABOUT 1 1/16 MILES ON THE TURF
FILLIES & MARES 4-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD
\$100,000

OVERVIEW:

The Stall Memorial kicks off the card's stakes action with a solid field of 8 runners set to do battle. Usually the turf races at Fair Grounds provide crazy results, so don't be afraid to take some shots in this race.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *My Philly Twirl*

Pressing Speed: *Carpe Vinum*

Stalkers: *Clara Peters, Soft Touch, Trail Ridge Road*

Closers: *Lake Lucerne, Island Hideaway, Russian Mafia*

It looks like My Philly Twirl could be alone on the lead in this spot. No other horse seems to want to run with her early; however, it should be noted that she had a similar setup last time out and lost.

TOP CHOICE: #7 TRAIL RIDGE ROAD

This filly has been solid on the turf in her last 2 tries, winning both including an allowance over this track last time out. She beat several of the same horses that are running in this race, which is a good sign. Trainer Chris Block is having a great meet at Fair Grounds so far and jockey Jareth Loveberry is riding with a lot of confidence. She should come running with a big move down the lane.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Clara Peeters, #4 My Philly Twirl, #6 Soft Touch

Clara Peeters runs off a layoff, but she has the class to be competitive. My Philly Twirl should be loose on the lead, which will make her tough to run down. Soft Touch was a close second last time out behind our top choice.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #8 Russian Mafia

This horse was a big price last time out but ran ok, finishing a close fourth behind our top pick. This will be her second straight race over the turf and she should sit a pretty decent trip in this spot.

OTHERS: #1 Carpe Vinum, #3 Lake Lucerne, #5 Island Hideaway

It'd be surprising to see any of these make an impact in this race. However, with turf horses, there is always a chance for some unexpected big improvement.

RACE No. 9:

COLONEL POWER STAKES

ABOUT 5 1/2 FURLONGS ON THE TURF
4-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD
\$100,000

OVERVIEW:

The Colonel Power keeps the stakes action rolling on this great 13-race card. A field of 8 will be sprinting on the turf in this spot, which could produce some nicely-priced results. This is a pretty evenly-matched race on paper.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Angaston*

Pressing Speed: *Twirling Roses, Yankee Seven*

Stalkers: *Ice Chocolat, Surveillance*

Closers: *All in Sync, Pyron, Manny Wah*

It looks like Angaston will be alone on the lead here, which is rare for a turf sprint, where the pace is usually lively. That should not be the case in the race, which looks to have a fairly slow pace on paper.

TOP CHOICE: #1 ICE CHOCOLAT

This horse was sharp in 2 straight efforts at Woodbine, winning an allowance on the turf 2 starts back before finishing second in a Grade 2 race over the synthetic surface last time out. Trainer Mark Casse usually does well shipping horses to Fair Grounds and this horse should get a solid trip from this inside post. He should come with a pretty solid run down the lane.

MAJOR THREATS: #3 All in Sync, #7 Angaston, #8 Surveillance

All in Sync gets class relief while making his first start off of a freshening. Angaston runs off of a layoff but looked solid in a turf allowance win in his last start. Surveillance moves to the turf today after 3 straight solid wins on dirt.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Pyron

At his best, this horse can win at this level, as he has done so in the past. However, we have not seen his best lately, so he will need to round back in form today off of a brief layoff.

OTHERS: #2 Twirling Roses, #5 Yankee Seven, #6 Manny Wah

This one seems pretty wide-open, so don't be afraid to play these horses if you see fit. It feels like a spot where anyone can win.

RACE No 10:

MINESHAFT STAKES (G3)

1 1/16 MILES ON THE DIRT
4-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD
\$250,000

OVERVIEW:

The Mineshaft kicks off the dirt stakes action and the Late Pick 4 on this 13-race card. A field of 9 is set to battle it out in this spot, which seems to be fairly competitive on paper.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Run Classic, Big Blue Line*

Pressing Speed: *Hoist the Gold*

Stalkers: *Pioneer of Medina, Mr. Wireless*

Closers: *Tawny Port, Farmington Road, Happy American, King Fury*

Run Classic should get to the lead, with Big Blue Line in second. Don't look for them to duel, though, as there is no other serious speed in the race.

TOP CHOICE: #3 TAWNY PORT

This horse developed nicely throughout the season last year for Brad Cox before finally showing up with a non-effort in the Pennsylvania Derby (G1). He has been off since that effort, which looked to be needed after a long season. If he shows up with his best effort today, then he will be competitive. He's been working fantastic over this track leading up to the race, which is a sign we might be ready to see some solid improvement from him.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Hoist the Gold, #6 Happy American, #8 Mr. Wireless

Hoist the Gold has been facing much better horses than what he'll see here and should be competitive if he handles stretching out in distance. Happy American has won 2 straight at this class level and over this surface. Mr. Wireless has run second to Happy American in 2 straight races.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Farmington Road

We'll see if he can bounce back from a total non-effort last time out over this track. Two starts back, he showed up with a solid win at Churchill Downs, defeating a few of the horses that are in this race.

OTHERS: #2 Run Classic, #5 Big Blue Line, #7 Pioneer of Medina, #9 King Fury

There are some solid horses in this category, but you can't use them all, so these are who we threw out. This is another race that looks wide open, though, so if one of these win, we won't be shocked.

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RACE No. 11:

FAIR GROUNDS STAKES (G3)

ABOUT 1 1/8 MILES ON THE TURF
4-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD
\$150,000

OVERVIEW:

We'll go back to the turf for the Fair Grounds, which drew a solid field of 8 runners. It sounds like a broken record, but the turf stakes on this card drew very well; this race looks as evenly matched as the others.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Two Emmys*

Pressing Speed: *Tiz the Bomb*

Stalkers: *Cavalry Charge, Gentle Soul Bay Street Money*

Closers: *English Tavern, Pixelate, Corelli*

It's likely we'll see an extremely slow pace in this one. Two Emmys should get the lead, with Tiz the Bomb in the mix as well, but neither of these horses should blaze fast early fractions.

TOP CHOICE: #2 TWO EMMYS

The pace of this race is going to tell the story. There is no early speed signed on to run here expect for Two Emmys, which means an aggressive ride should give him a big advantage. When he wins at this level, he does it in gate to wire fashion, and he absolutely should get that setup today. Getting him to the front has to be the plan today, and if it is, then he should be tough to pass.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Tiz the Bomb, #7 Corelli, #8 Bay Street Money

Tiz the Bomb returns from a layoff, which looked needed after a long 2022 campaign. He should run well in this spot. Corelli should improve in his second race off of the layoff. Bay Street Money has won 2 of his past 3 starts.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #6 Pixelate

This horse should improve while moving back to the turf after a poor effort over the dirt last time out. He is much better over the turf, and if his price floats up, then he will be worth a play.

OTHERS: #3 Cavalry Charge, #4 Gentle Soul, #5 English Tavern

These three look a bit overmatched, but crazier things happen on this turf course, and a couple of these have popped over this track at a big price.

RACE No 12:

RACHEL ALEXANDRA STAKES (G2)

1 1/16 MILES ON THE DIRT
FILLIES 3-YEAR-OLDS
\$300,000

OVERVIEW:

In some ways, this year's running of the Rachel Alexandra is just as big of a deal as the Risen Star. It's only a small field of six, but the return of early Kentucky Oaks favorite Hoosier Philly headlines the race. Will she take her first step towards Kentucky Oaks glory?

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Miracle*

Pressing Speed: *Hoosier Philly*

Stalkers: *Vahva, Pretty Mischievous*

Closers: *Knockyoursocksoff, Chop Chop*

This is another race that looks like it will have a slow pace. Miracle will likely make the lead; however, Hoosier Philly will be her tracking her closely in second, ready to pounce at the right time.

TOP CHOICE: #2 HOOSIER PHILLY

As of now, this is the number one-ranked horse for the Kentucky Oaks, so we'll see how she comes back in her 3-year-old debut. She was simply dominant in her last 2 starts at this distance and she seems to be working out like a freak leading up to this race. All signs are that she is ready to fire a big effort, and her main competition is a horse she easily beat in her last start at Churchill Downs.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 Chop Chop, #5 Pretty Mischievous

Chop Chop was close last time out over this track but couldn't finish the job, and this race seems to be a bigger challenge. Pretty Mischievous was sharp in victory last time out over this track, but she was no match for our top choice 2 starts back.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Vahva

We'll see if she can rebound after a poor effort last time out. She bounced out of that race with 2 solid works and we know that she is better than what she showed us last time out. Look for her to bounce back with a nice effort.

OTHERS: #3 Knockyoursocksoff, #6 Miracle

These are both nice horses, but they are up against a very tough field here. We aren't sure that they are ready for this level quite yet.

RACE No13:

RISEN STAR STAKES (G2)

1 1/8 MILES ON THE DIRT
3-YEAR-OLDS
\$400,000

OVERVIEW:

The main event is here, and it looks great, with 14 runners shooting for Risen Star Stakes (G2) glory. The Fair Grounds circuit has been great in producing runners the last few years, while this field suggests they could be headed for more solid production this season.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: Harlocap, Victory Formation

Pressing Speed: Determinedly, Two Phil's

Stalkers: Single Ruler, Shaq Diesel, Tapit's Conquest, Curly Jack, Silver Heist

Closers: Quiet as Midnight, Angel of Empire, Sun Thunder, Crupi, Private Creed

Simply put, this should be a pretty fast pace. Several of these horses do their best running on or near the lead.

TOP CHOICE: #13 VICTORY FORMATION

This undefeated colt hasn't been overly flashy, but he's shown solid talent in each of his wins. He's sired by a Belmont Stakes winner and looks like a horse who should get better as the distances get longer. We should see more improvement while stretching out in a race that seems perfect for him. The outside post could become a problem, so he'll need to break well to get early position.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Harlocap, #8 Tapit's Conquest, #9 Curly Jack, #12 Crupi

Harlocap moves to the Steve Asmussen barn after a solid maiden win last time out at Santa Anita for Bob Baffert. Tapit's Conquest should run better in his second start over the surface. Curly Jack was solid as a 2-year-old and seems well-prepared for his seasonal debut. Crupi is still a maiden but should close with a big run down the lane.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #14 Private Creed

It's interesting to see him entered here after running on turf his entire career. He's also been mostly a sprinter as well, but he did run well in a stakes while stretching out last time at Sam Houston. Tyler Gaffalione jumping aboard is a good sign.

OTHERS: #1 Quiet as Midnight, #2 Single Ruler, #3 Shaq Diesel, #4 Determinedly, #6 Angel of Empire, #7 Sun Thunder, #10 Two Phil's, #11 Silver Heist

There seems to be a lot of filler in this race today; however, some of these in this group still have an outside shot. Two Phil's is the one we are most interested in seeing after finishing a solid second last time out in the Lecomte Stakes (G3).
