**Summary:** Trainer Bob Baffert has three runners in this race, including the two main speed horses, which means he should be able to control the early tempo. If he does, the others will be hard pressed to catch #3 National Treasure or #5 Muth, who already seems like the horses to beat regardless of the pace.

These are always tricky races to handicap when one trainer has multiple horses that show early speed. I project **#3 National Treasure** gets the lead, and **#5 Muth** stalks the pace, setting up a match race down the stretch. I think National Treasure will be able to hold him off if he gets out to a comfortable lead.

#### BET ANALYSIS

This really feels like a match race between the two main Bob Baffert horses. And while I do respect the **#3 National Treasure**, I'm a big believer in the **#5 Muth**. He's healthy, filled out, and should run huge here in a prep for the Classic. Fairly confident in him in this spot but won't be easy.

Del Mar is a track where you need to be close to the front, especially in sprint races, so don't automatically assume a horse will win from behind if the pace looks hot on paper.

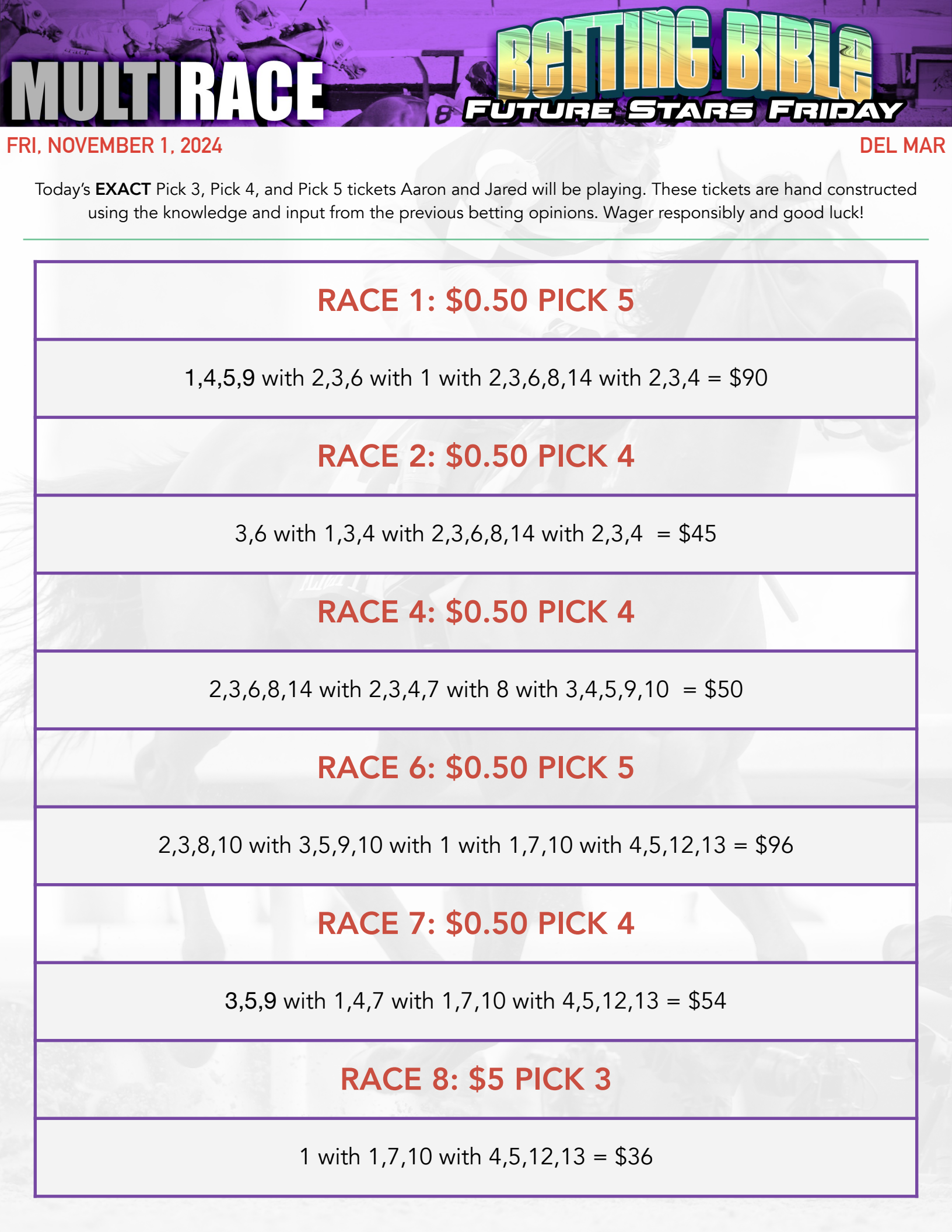

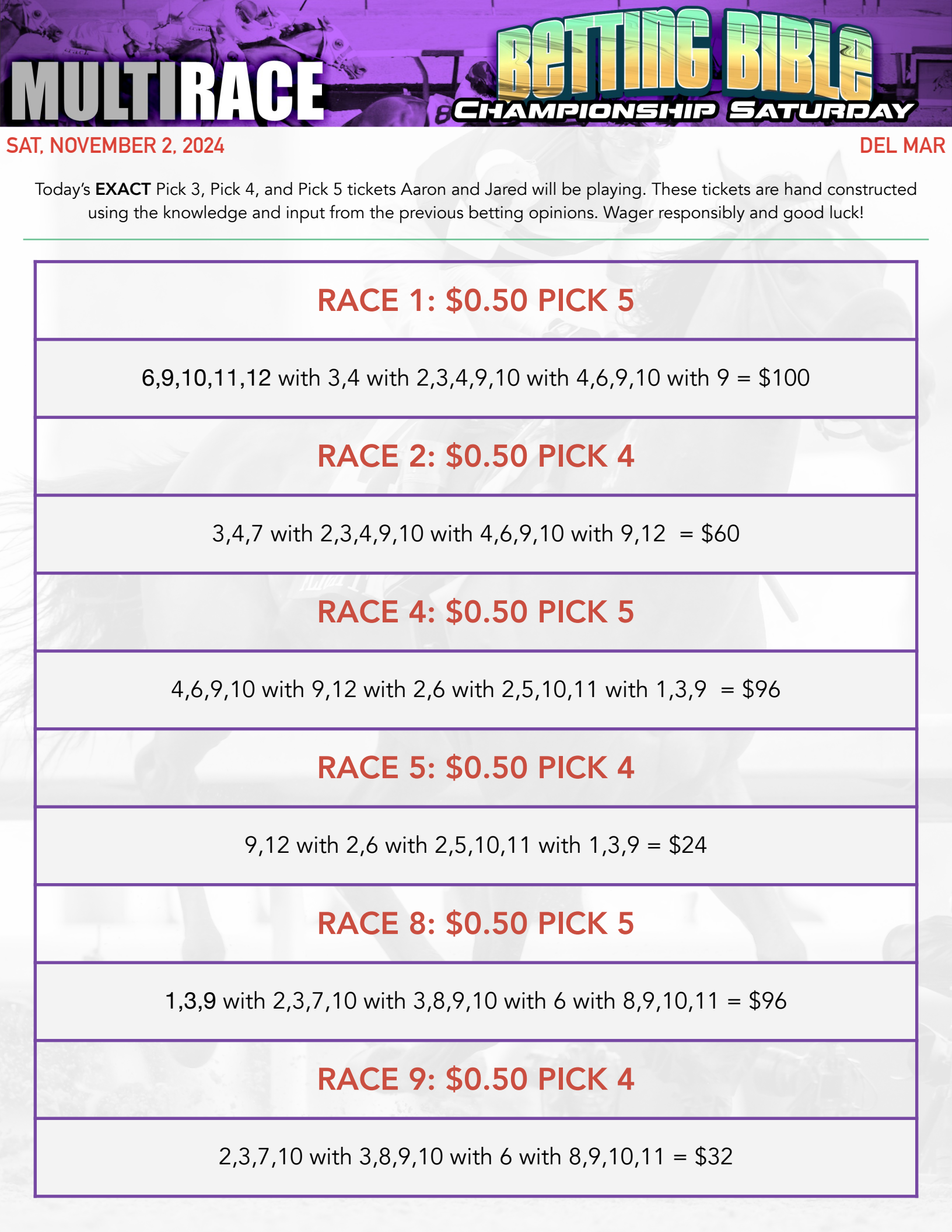

# FUTURE STARS FRIDAY

NOVEMBER 1

## JUVENILE TURF SPRINT

Speed, speed, speed! In the six years they have ran this race, speed has won five of them. This is now an established trend and when a trend is winning at an 83% clip, you listen. It's also worth noting that these five very fast winners have won at an average price of 3-1

*Takeaway:* Find the fastest horse with the lowest odds and call 'em home!

## JUVENILE FILLIES

This feels repetitive at this point but here we go again this year. Now just twice in the last 12 years has the post-time favorite won the Juvenile Fillies (Echo Zulu in 2021 and Songbird in 2015). It takes a great filly to win this race as a favorite and we thought Tamara could do it last year. We all know how that worked out

*Takeaway:* Bob Baffert has some runners but expect the undefeated Non Compliant to be favorite. If you don't think she's Echo Zulu or Songbird, try to beat her with someone like Brad Cox's Immersive.

# FUTURE STARS FRIDAY

## NOVEMBER 1

### JUVENILE FILLIES TURF

Another trend that continues to grow strength each year. American-based trainers have won the Juvenile Fillies Turf in 13 of its 16 runnings (81%), making this easily our most dominant turf race at the Breeders' Cup. Chad Brown, who won this race last year with Hard to Justify, has contributed 6 of those 13 US victories.

**Takeaway:** *With Chad Brown seemingly not having any serious runners in the race, you'll have to lean on another American-based runner like Phil D'Amato's Thought Process.*

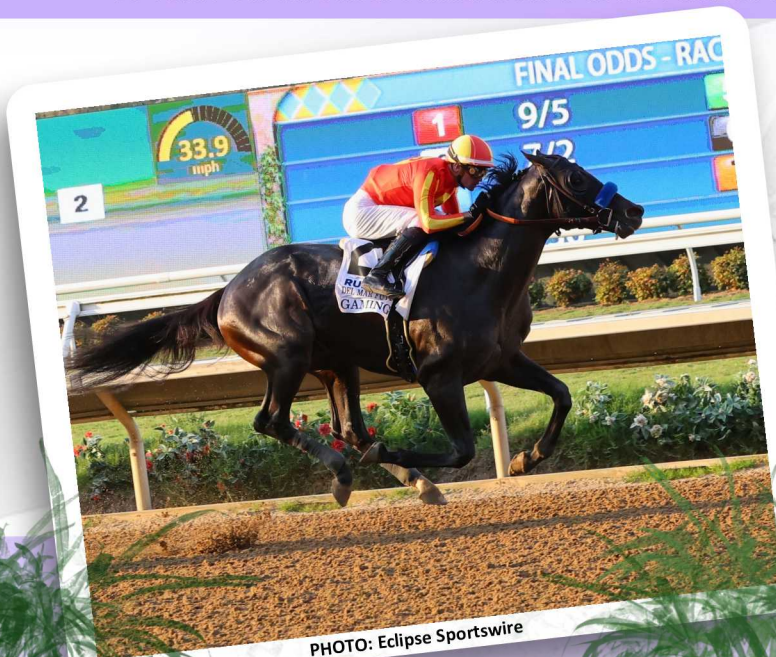

### JUVENILE

This is such an interesting trend. The winner of this race will become one of the classier horses in the crop. In fact, 8 of the last 9 FanDuel Juvenile winners (Fierceness, Forte, Essential Quality, Storm the Court, Game Winner, Good Magic, Classic Empire, and Nyquist) each made it to the Kentucky Derby the following year. Only ONE of those horses went off as the favorite in the FanDuel Juvenile (Game Winner).

**Takeaway:** *With Bob Baffert back in the Kentucky Derby mix, don't bet class here. Bet future class.*



# FUTURE STARS FRIDAY

## NOVEMBER 1

### JUVENILE TURF

European-based horses have won the Juvenile Turf 13 times in the 17-year history of the race (76%). Of those 13, Aidan O'Brien and Charlie Appleby have won a combined 9 times at an average price of 5-1, including the last three years!

**Takeaway:** *Aidan O'Brien and Charlie Appleby have yet to solidify who exactly will come over and run here, but expect there to be options. Take the most appealing one and play everything around it.*

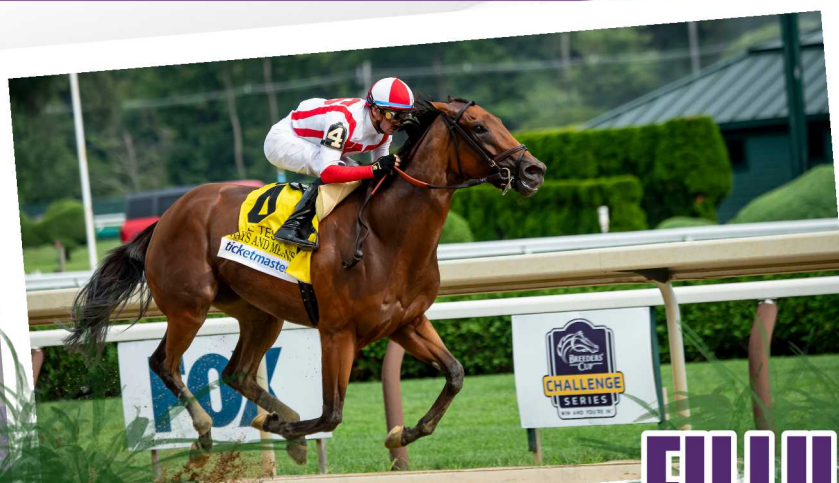

### FILLY & MARE SPRINT

Having speed in the Filly & Mare Sprint may be the kiss of death. In fact, in its 17 years of existence, no horse has won this race gate to wire. It just simply doesn't hold up.

**Takeaway:** *For the last two years, this guide has predicted that eventual winner Goodnight Olive would be a horse to play from off the pace. This year, the setup could be there for a horse like Ways and Means if she can sit off the pace.*

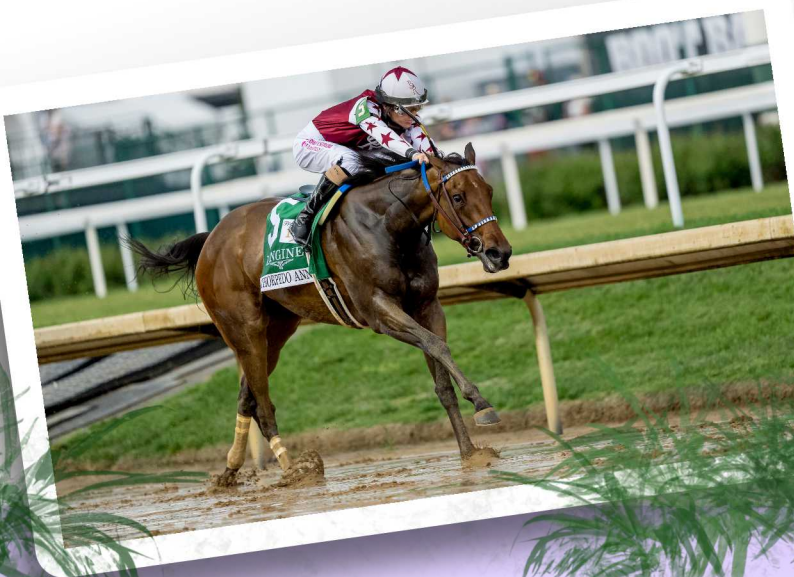




## TURF SPRINT

Since moving this race to 5 furlongs in 2019, we've seen almost nothing but speed win the Turf Sprint. However, that trend as bucked last year with Nobals and in 2020 when Glass Slippers won, who also became the first (and only) international horse to win the race in 16 runnings.

**Takeaway:** *If you think the Euro Bradsell can upset the speeding American Cogburn you may want to think again. Play an American speed here and don't think twice about it.*



## DISTAFF

The Distaff is all about class. Zenyatta, Royal Delta (2x), Beholder, Untapable, Monomoy Girl (2x), Malathaat, and Idiomatic all have won this race in the past. Take out the Japanese-bred Marche Lorraine winning at 50/1 in 2021, and we've seen the winner's odds at less than 5/1 over the past 15+ years.

Additionally, the last two 3-year-olds to win the Distaff (Untapable and Monomoy Girl) also won the Kentucky Oaks earlier in the year.

**Takeaway:** *Kentucky Oaks winner Thorpedo Anna has entered the chat. She has the class and she has the ability.*



## TURF

Another turf race that the Euros just dominate. In fact, in the past 20 years, European-based horses have won the Turf 15 times (75%)! That includes the past 4 years and 8 of the last 10! Just pure domination. Perhaps even more interesting is that of those 15 Euro winners, they have only been the favorite 3 times with average winning odds of nearly 7/1!

*Takeaway:* With City Of Troy aiming at the Classic, there doesn't appear to be any true international superstars aiming for this race. Look for the classiest Euro/Japan horse with odds between 5-1 and 10-1 and roll the dice.

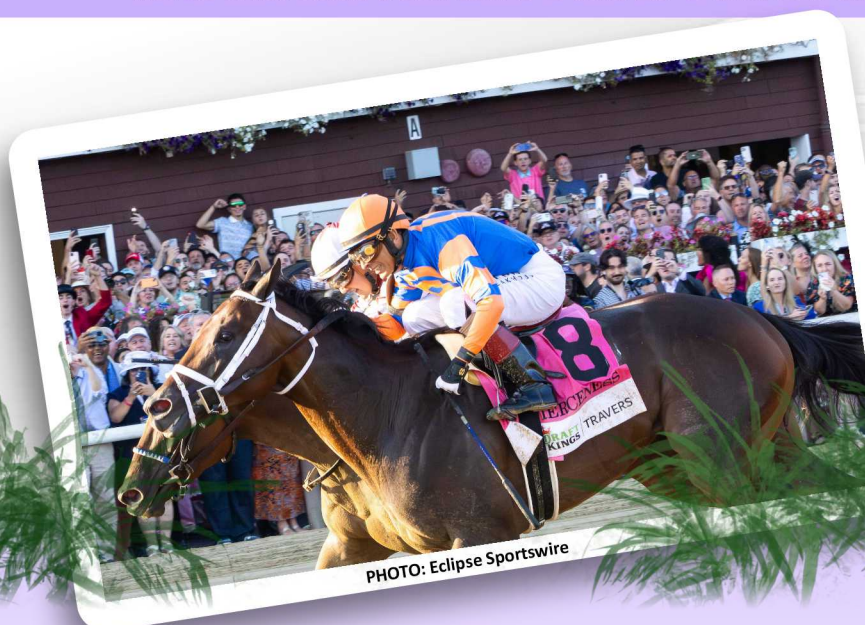

## CLASSIC

Interesting fact. Did you know that the favorite has only won the Classic 4 times in the past 14 years? However, even when the favorite loses, the average winning odds are less than 5-1 over that same 14 year time period. In fact, the winner has been one of the top 3 betting options in each of the last 10 years, and the average winning odds since 1999 for the Classic winner were 7.5-1!

*Takeaway:* Simply put, you did not need to look past the logical winners in the Classic. Class wins this race.



# FILLY & MARE TURF

This trend is about as automatic as they come. International trainers have won the Filly & Mare Turf 7 of the last 8 runnings, with the only time they didn't it was with Chad Brown and Sistercharlie (IRE). And since Brown doesn't have Sistercharlie in here this year, look for this trend to continue to be automatic.

*Takeaway:* There is a long list of international-based horses looking to come over for this one, including a horse trained by the legend John Gosden. Euros will win this one.

# SPRINT

Easily the most automatic trend of the Breeders' Cup. Only 2 horses in the last 26 years (Reraise in 1998 and Big Drama in 2010) have won the Sprint going gate to wire. You just cannot do it. And it defies logic because we've seen some very, very fast horses try to do it. Furthermore, in the last 10 runnings, the winner has only been the favorite twice with average winning odds of 7/1!

*Takeaway:* Look for horses who you know will not be on the lead and demand value! Japan's Remake just may fit this bill.



## SATURDAY

NOVEMBER 2

## MILE

Check this out. Charlie Appleby has never ran a horse in the Mile who has lost. You read that right. Appleby has won this race the last three runnings (Master of The Seas, Modern Games, and Space Blues). In fact, Appleby now has 10 winners from 20 starters at the Breeders' Cup. We will just call this the "Appleby Trend".

**Takeaway:** *Notable Speech looks to come to California and is the likely favorite to give Appleby, Godolphin, and jockey William Buick their fourth straight Mile.*

## DIRT MILE

Is it still a trend if the trend has been bucked the last two years? However, the only reason it was is because of a horse named Cody's Wish who won this race in back-to-back years. What trend is that? SPEED. City of Light, Spun to Run, Knicks Go, and Life Is Good were all speed. Both Cyberknife in 2022 and National Treasure in 2023 nearly did it as well if not for the beast.

**Takeaway:** *A horse like Saudi Crown would make a lot of sense. He has the class. He has the speed. And he has the trainer who knows how to get his horses to fire their best in this race.*
