It's time for the main event! The Breeders' Cup is finally here, and the Dudes are ready to go! This year, we're giving you the exact race by race wagering plan of Aaron and Jared while they are LIVE at the Breeders' Cup betting throughout the two days. You can play these tickets exactly, or you can take our opinions and sprinkle in your own thoughts as well. The decision is ultimately up to you. Ultimately, we shot for a budget of approximately \$550.

Let's not waste any more time. Here's the wagering plan for all 14 of this years Breeders' Cup races.

Friday Race #6: JUVENILE TURF SPRINT

We won't get cute with this race. Golden Pal simply seems to be a major standout from a class perspective and could have a lot of upside coming into this race, so we might see his best performance of the year here. We're making a simple win wager on him to kick off the Breeders' Cup.

We are both fans of European horses in this spot, especially Sealiway and Battleground. We'll use those two heavy in an exacta and on top in a trifecta, where we'll spread underneath with Cadillac and Go Athletico. It's a risk using all Euros here, but they just seem to be classier than their American counterparts this year.

Friday Race #8: JUVENILE FILLIES

We're not going to get fancy with our wagers here, either. With just 7 horses in the field, it's hard to see the exotic wagers paying much unless you like longshots, which we don't. Simply Ravishing to win seems to be the most logical play. Her win over the track was awesome and though she's 5/2, she still provides value.

Saturday Race #6: DIRT MILE

It's really hard to believe that we both like Knicks Go so much. The simple truth is that he's turned into a monster since moving to the Brad Cox barn. Last time out, he destroyed optional claiming company over this track that set a new track record going slightly longer; a similar effort wins this race. We'll use him on top in an exacta and sprinkle in longshots underneath to hopefully juice up the payouts.

We went with Audarya and Terebellum as potential upsetters and played small win wagers on them at double-digit odds. We also played them on top in a trifecta with Rushing Fall and Mean Mary underneath. Finally, just in case Rushing Fall wins, we played one saver ticket with her on top in a trifecta with four horses mixed into the other slots.

Her only real threat is Swiss Skydiver, who might be better going longer. If Monomoy Girl runs her top race, then the rest of these horse will be running for second. We went with a large win wager on her.

The European horses should dominate in this spot, and after watching hours of replays, it's hard not to have strong respect for Magical, the classiest horse in the race. However, the Dudes both fell in love with Tarnawa, who looked like one of the best horses in the world. We decided to load up on these two with a big exacta box.

Saturday Race #12: CLASSIC

It's the race of the year, for Horse of the Year, and we couldn't be more excited. From a betting standpoint, the first decision is whether to play trainer Bob Baffert's trio or fade them. We've decided to fade them in the exacta, playing a nice box with Tom's d'Etat and Tiz the Law, our top two choices in the race. For the trifecta and superfecta, it's harder to get completely away from Baffert, so we used Improbable and Maximum Security. We also have Authentic in the third spot in one trifecta, along with Tacitus, Global Campaign, and By My Standards. This is one of the deepest Classic fields that we've seen in several years.

BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE TURF SPRINT [G2]

OVERVIEW:

For the third straight year, this event kicks off the Friday Breeders' Cup action and drew a full field, making it a big success compared to the now-defunct Juvenile Dirt Sprint. Trainer Wesley Ward will aim to win this race for the second straight season with plenty of ammo.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: Bodenheimer, Cowan, Golden Pal, Momos

Pressing Speed: Amanzi Yimpilo, Into the Sunrise, Country Final, Windy City Red

Stalkers: Lipizzaner, Ubettavelieveit, Dirty Dangle

Closers: After Five, Mighty Gurkha, Second of July

We'll probably see a fast pace in this race every year that it's contested. A gate-to-wire runner has won each year, though, so early speed may be the key to victory.

TOP CHOICE: #14 GOLDEN PAL

Ward seems to hold the strongest hand in this race by far. He has several potential star horses in here, but we're taking Golden Pal on top. He has progressed nicely leading up to this event and has shown world-class talent in each of his past starts. Look for him to run a huge race.

MAJOR THREATS: #3 Lipizzaner, #6 Ubettabelieveit, #9 After Five

Europeans often don't do as well as Americans in sprints, but at 20/1, both Lipizzaner and Ubettabelieveit are ultra-intriguing and have had success at this distance overseas. After Five is still a maiden, which is not ideal, but he has had tough trips in both starts. With a better trip here, he can make some noise at a price.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #7 Momos, #8 Amanzi Yimpilo, #10 Bodenheimer,

Momos could improve as he makes his second turf start. Amaniz Yimpilo won the Speakeasy Stakes at Santa Anita last time out. Bodenheimer won the Indian Summer Stakes over this track while leading every step.

OTHERS: #1 Mighty Gurkha, #2 Windy City Red, #4 County Final, #5 Cowan, #11 Into the Sunrise, #12 Dirty Dangle, #13 Second of July

A lot of these horses seem to be trying to take a swing at the easiest BC race in which to hit the board. Don't look for any of these to make much of an impact here.

BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE TURF [G1]

OVERVIEW:

This event has been dominated by Europeans in the past and another strong contingent has shipped in for this year's running, but the North American turf juveniles also look strong this year. That combination should make for an ultra-competitive contest.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Gretzky the Great, Outadore*

Pressing Speed: *Battleground, Ebeko, Go Athletico, The Lir Jet*

Stalkers: *Abarta, New Mandate, Sealiway*

Closers: *Cadillac, Devilwala, Fire at Will, Mutasaabeq, Public Sector*

A large field usually leads to a hot pace, which should be the case in this spot. The closers should have a fair shot with this much speed signed on to run.

TOP CHOICE: #1 SEALIWAY (FR)

European runners have been so dominant in this race recently that it makes it tough to not pick one - especially when one has looked as impressive as Sealiway has this year. He has plenty of experience under his belt and the competition that he's faced in the past is tougher than what he'll see here.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 New Mandate, #5 Cadillac, #9 Battleground, #11 Gretzky the Great, #12 Go Athletico

European shippers also dominate this category - New Mandate, Cadillac, Battleground, and Go Athletico all come to Keeneland with solid overseas form. Gretzky the Great is an intriguing shipper from Woodbine who has won 3 straight.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #6 Mutasaabeq, #8 Outadore, #13 Devilwala

Mutasaabeq won the Bourbon Stakes (G2) over this track last time out, but did not get a fast speed figure. Outadore stretches out in distance for this race, but he has 2 solid wins under his belt. Devilwala is a European shipper who might appreciate firmer ground here.

OTHERS: #3 Abarta, #4 Public Sector, #7 Fire at Will, #10 Ebeko, #14 The Lir Jet

There are some talented runners in this group, but you just can't play them all without breaking the bank. Longshot European invader The Lir Jet has performed well against tougher company and beat Golden Pal at Royal Ascot earlier this year.

BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE FILLIES [G1]

OVERVIEW:

A strong field with a lot of promise will contend this year's running. The field is a bit shorter than normal, but that could be due to the strength at the top. We have several solid options to play in this spot.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Dayoutoftheoffice, Vequist*

Pressing Speed: *Girl Daddy, Princess Noor, Simply Ravishing*

Stalkers: *Thoughtfully*

Closers: *Crazy Beautiful*

In yet another race on Friday that should yield a swift pace up front, the closers and stalkers should get a fair shot in this race. However, several quality speed horses will have a shot to stick it out to the wire up front, too.

TOP CHOICE: #1 SIMPLY RAVISHING

She crushed her rivals last time out in the Alcibiades Stakes (G1) in what was an extremely impressive race over the local course. She also crushed her rivals by several lengths at Saratoga prior to the Alcibiades. This is a tough spot, but she's the one to beat.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Vequist,
#3 Dayoutoftheoffice, #7 Princess Noor

Vequist is an upset candidate whose sire won the BC Juvenile in 2015 over this track. Dayoutoftheoffice has been a monster in her last 2 races, but those were one-turn events; this distance is a question mark. Princess Noor has won all 3 starts, including the Chandelier Stakes (G1) at Santa Anita while going this distance.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #5 Girl Daddy

Trainer Dale Romans seems to hold the wild card in both Juvenile dirt divisions. This filly has won both of her career starts by multiple lengths, including the Pocahontas Stakes (G3) at Churchill Downs last time out.

OTHERS: #4 Thoughtfully, #6 Crazy Beautiful

Thoughtfully and Crazy Beautiful are each nice prospects capable of making an impact here, but both were defeated fairly easily by our top pick last time out. It's hard to see them turning the tables on that horse here.

BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE FILLIES TURF [G1]

OVERVIEW:

American horses have kept the Euros from winning this race in most years, but some tough runners have shipped over to contest it this season. Will the trend continue? This is always one of the more challenging races of the entire weekend to handicap.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Aunt Pearl, Campanelle*

Pressing Speed: *Miss Amulet, Royal Approval, Spanish Loveaffair*

Stalkers: *Madone, Nazuna, Oodnadatta, Plum Ali, Union Gables*

Closers: *Alda, Tetragonal, Editor At Large, Mother Earth*

They won't be flying in this one, which should give Aunt Pearl and Campanelle a solid shot at kicking clear of the majority of these fillies.

TOP CHOICE: #4 PLUM ALI

Historically, an American horse has won this race more often than a European shipper. This trend has a great shot to continue, especially with the likes of Plum Ali and Aunt Pearl entered into the race. Both of these fillies look primed and ready to win, but we went with Plum Ali on top because of her speed figure advantage.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Miss Amulet, #5 Aunt Pearl, #10 Campanelle, #14 Editor At Large

Miss Amulet is a solid European shipper who could be primed to upset, and the American-based Campanelle won both of her European starts. Aunt Pearl was ultra-impressive when wiring the Jessamine Stakes (G2), the local prep. Editor At Large hails from trainer Chad Brown, who always runs well in this race.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Oodnadatta, #3 Alda, #8 Mother Earth, #9 Madone, #12 Spanish Loveaffair

Oodnadatta and Mother Earth are both interesting overseas prospects. Alda missed in the Natalma Stakes (G1) narrowly last time out. Madone is undefeated in 3 starts but must travel outside of California for the first time. Spanish Loveaffair has been solid in all 3 starts, including a runner-up effort to Aunt Pearl last time out.

OTHERS: #6 Nazuna, #7 Tetragonal, #11 Royal Approval, #13 Union Gables

Royal Approval and Union Gables entered the incorrect race, in our opinion. The others look a bit out-classed in this ultra-difficult event.

OVERVIEW:

We'll see who takes the first major step towards the 2021 Kentucky Derby out of a field that's one of the best we've seen in several recent runnings. The winner will most likely be the 2-Year-Old Male of the Year and the race could produce several Derby starters.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Classier, Jackie's Warrior, Likeable*
Pressing Speed: *Camp Hope, Dreamer's Disease, Essential Quality, Next, Reinvestment Risk*
Stalkers: *Calibrate, Sittin On Go, Hot Rod Charlie*
Closers: *Keepmeinmind, King Fury, Rombauer*

Jackie's Warrior has shown plenty of early speed in 3 starts, but Classier won't be far behind. The pace should be honest, but Jackie's Warrior might simply outclass this group, regardless of the pace setup.

TOP CHOICE: #7 JACKIE'S WARRIOR

It's been a back-and-forth decision between this horse and Essential Quality, but Jackie's Warrior seems a bit more developed and professional, which ultimately made the difference. It's shaping up to be a showdown.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Essential Quality, #9 Sittin On Go

Essential Quality is the obvious second choice to the heavy favorite. He was very impressive in the Breeders' Futurity (G1) last time out and trainer Brad Cox is extremely high on him. Sittin On Go could play the big upsetter for trainer Dale Romans. He could improve with more racing under his belt.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Reinvestment Risk, #4 Likeable, #8 Classier

Reinvestment Risk is solid but was no match for our top choice in his last 2 starts. Likeable broke his maiden like a pro last time out at Belmont Park. Classier comes into this race off of a debut maiden special weight win for tough luck trainer Bob Baffert.

OTHERS: #1 Camp Hope, #2 King Fury, #6 Keepmeinmind, #10 Dreamer's Disease, #11 Next, #12 Hot Rod Charlie, #13 Rombauer, #14 Calibrate

This year's running is extremely top-heavy, which makes this group hard-pressed to make an impact. They'll really have to step up their games to compete with the likes of Jackie's Warrior and Essential Quality.

VALUE PLAYS

Put the world's best horses into full fields of the most competitive races and you get great betting opportunities. That's what the Breeders' Cup (BC) Saturday card is all about, giving handicappers and bettors 9 races of pure horse racing bliss.

With so many talented horses in each race, Grade 1 winners and other elite runners get lost in the pari-mutuel pools, going off at long odds and providing tremendous value. Identifying those horses is a key focus, but handicapping is only the start of formulating a prosperous World Championship weekend at Keeneland.

Once you determine which horses you want to use in your wagers, you must determine how to play your opinions through a slew of in-race and multi-race wagering pools. Can you connect two or three winners in a row and hit a Daily Double or a Pick 3? If you like a longshot closer to hit the board, how do you play that closer in an exacta or a trifecta? I will address those questions in this "2020 Breeders' Cup Saturday Value Plays" article.

Since money management is imperative, I'll use a \$200 budget to construct 10 tickets equaling \$20 approximately each. You only have to be right a few times during the Breeders' Cup to come out a winner, as they say, so let's find value plays and construct our winning tickets right now!

SATURDAY'S EARLY PICK 3

We'll shoot for value in this Pick 3 by playing against all three favorites. The first leg (the Filly & Mare Sprint) is a bit murky, especially with **#2 Gamine** headlining despite 2 positive drug tests after her last 4 races for trainer Bob Baffert. She may fall into a pace duel with multiple Grade

1 winner **#7 Serengeti Empress**, who showed in the Ballerina Stakes (G1) at Saratoga that she can go fast early and still keep going. However, she was nipped late at the wire in the Derby City Distaff (G1) by **#9 Bell's the One**, and the same thing may happen here, so Ticket #1 is a \$3 Pick 3 using only Serengeti Empress and Bell's the One in this first leg.

Next up is the Turf Sprint, and **#7 Leinster** absolutely loves the Keeneland turf. I am steadfastly dedicated to wagering on horses who have previously performed well at Keeneland, especially over the turf, and the Rusty Arnold trainee won both big local turf sprint stakes this year, the Shakertown (G2) and the Woodford (G2). Leinster should get a stalking trip off the early speed here. **#3 Imprimis** is the only other horse I'll use in this Pick 3. He's crossed the wire first in 2 top turf sprint stakes this year and has always been highly regarded. I'll play against the favorite **#12 Got Stormy**, who will take a lot of money and whose Brisnet speed figures in turf sprints are a bit lower than my top two choices.

In the last leg of this Pick 3, I'll use **#5 Knicks Go** and **#2 Sharp Samurai** in the wide-open Big Ass Fans Dirt Mile. Knicks Go appears to have a pace advantage as the best early speed, and if he sets a steady pace before entering the short stretch run to the wire, then he'll be tough to reel in late. He's another horse who loves Keeneland and has been rejuvenated since moving to the Brad Cox barn; he set the track record for 1 1/16 miles in his last start. If Knicks Go falters, then Sharp Samurai should be sitting off the pace and may capitalize under two-time defending Eclipse Award-winning jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. Sharp Samurai was second last time out in the City of Hope Mile Stakes (G2) on turf behind the talented Mo Forza, and he was second before that in the Pacific Classic Stakes (G1) on dirt

behind top older male Maximum Security, so he has kept good company. *Sharp Samurai is a great value play at his 15/1 morning line.*

DOUBLE TO THE QUEEN

Since I like Knicks Go and Sharp Samurai in the Dirt Mile, I have no issue trying to press them to favorite **#6 Rushing Fall** in the Maker's Mark Filly & Mare Turf, creating a \$10 Double for Ticket #2.

Rushing Fall is the ultimate Keeneland turf lover, having won a Grade 1 over this grass an astounding 4 years in a row! **#4 Mean Mary** will likely lead in this race, but Rushing Fall should be able to stalk and track her down, similarly to what happened in the Diana Stakes (G1) at Saratoga back in August. The Chad Brown star will run the farthest of her career and will need to hold off stablemates **#2 Sistercharlie** and **#5 My Sister Nat**, along with European invader **#11 Audarya** and Canadian Horse of the Year **#1 Starship Jubilee**, but Rushing Fall is a Hall of Famer and should go out on top in her final start before retirement.

SPRINT EXACTA BOX

Next up is the Sprint, and it's likely that the Steve Asmussen speedster **#10 Yaupon** will get the early lead. The field's only filly **#6 Frank's Rockette** and their fellow 3-year-old **#9 Empire of Gold** will keep company early, with the 3/1 morning line favorite **#14 Vekoma** now scratched from the race. Vekoma hadn't raced since July 4 when he won the Met Mile (G1) impressively, so while the George Weaver charge would have had the best horse in this race, it's not a surprise that he had to scratch out of this spot.

Perhaps his paddling style of running finally caught up to him physically. He's would have been work playing against, especially since he drew the far outside post, but we don't have to worry about him now.

It's possible that Yaupon will put Frank's Rockette and Empire of Gold away while **#11 Diamond Oops** makes a stretch run. I'm playing the scenario that the versatile Diamond Oops - who just recently won the Phoenix Stakes (G2) over this dirt track and distance - gets past the front runners and duels to the finish with the undefeated Yaupon. Therefore, Ticket #3 plays a \$10 exacta box in the Sprint using Diamond Oops and Yaupon. *Diamond Oops may be in the 8/1 range here, which would make him a definite value play.*

One last note on the Sprint: I can't forget about the old warrior **#7 Whitmore**, who makes his fourth try in the BC Sprint. He will be mixed into any trifectas or superfectas that I play in this race.

MILE STYLE

#11 Ivar comes off an impressive local win in the Shadwell Turf Mile (G1) in early October. **#13 Factor This** and **#10 Halladay** should bump heads early and set a fast pace while Ivar sits off before getting the jump on the late closers.

The main horses flying late will be recent Turf Classic (G1) winner **#5 Digital Age** and 2019 BC Mile winner **#12 Uni**, both trained by Chad Brown. Digital Age is in the best form of his career, according to a recent quote from Brown, and Uni's recent First Lady Stakes (G1) win showed that she's back in form. That was also her second Grade 1 win over this sod.

Even though the pace may be faster than what the Europeans are accustomed to seeing, one invading longshot who is worth playing to hit the board is **#4 Siskin**. Though only a 3-year old, he has fared admirably against several top European elders in his past 2 races. He will likely be a big price, and when owner/breeder Juddmonte Farms send one to the BC, I am always interested.

In Ticket #4, I will play a \$10 exacta box with Ivar and Digital Age. In Ticket #5, I will box my top 4 choices (Ivar, Digital Age, Uni, and Siskin) in a \$1 trifecta box for a \$24 total ticket. *Both Digital Age at 8/1 and Siskin at 12/1 are value plays in the Mile.*

CHAMPIONSHIP PICK 3

Several divisional championships and year-end honors will be decided in the last 3 races of the BC, starting with the Distaff. **#10 Monomoy Girl** has won 3 straight in 2020 after a 1 1/2-year layoff. She won this race in 2018 as a 3-year-old but has been more workmanlike than flashy this year. The Brad Cox-trained super-mare won the 2018 Ashland Stakes (G1) over this dirt and will likely be one of the biggest favorites of the BC. She is a must-use to start the late Pick 3.

There isn't much value in playing both Monomoy Girl and the Preakness Stakes (G1) winner **#5 Swiss Skydiver** in this race; they'll be the two top betting choices by a wide margin. After firing a big shot in the Preakness, this will be Swiss Skydiver's tenth race at her ninth different track in 2020, an especially amazing feat considering that she raced straight through the pandemic. If she wants the lead here, she'll have to outkick **#6 Lady Kate** and **#9 Ollie's Candy**; it's more likely that she sits just off those foes.

Swiss Skydiver may be softened up after her long campaign, which could set up for a horse to come from off the pace. My bet is with **#8 Valiance**, a Todd Pletcher filly who has come into her own since switching to dirt. She won the local Spinster Stakes (G1) at this distance in her final prep and Pletcher won this race in 2015 when it was run at Keeneland with value play Stopchargingmaria.

For Ticket #6, I'll try to beat Swiss Skydiver and get either Monomoy Girl or Valiance home to start this \$2 Pick 3.

TURF TRIFECTA

#2 Magical, **#10 Mogul**, **#3 Tarnawa**, and **#6 Lord North** lead the European invaders in a rendition of the BC Turf that they should dominate. Magical is possibly the classiest horse running in the entire BC this year; the 5-year-old mare has 7 Group 1 wins on her illustrious resume for trainer Aidan O'Brien, who has won the BC Turf a record 6 times. O'Brien also sends the imposing 3-year-old Mogul, who won the Grand Prix de Paris (G1) last time out with a devastating turn-of-foot in the stretch that throttled the field. Both are must-uses in all BC Turf wagers.

The filly Tarnawa comes to the US after earning a pair of Group 1 wins and will take on males for the first time. The pace should set up for her, but trainer Dermot Weld - one of the top trainers overseas - has yet to win a BC race in 16 tries. Of the Euros I mentioned, I'm willing to play against Lord North, who hasn't yet gone this distance and may be off form after a tough tenth-place finish in the British Champions Stakes (G1) over soft going.

From the Americans, I am most interested in getting **#1 Arklow** in the number. Trainer Brad Cox recently said that Arklow is entering this BC in the best form of his career, and the pace should set up for his late run to possibly hit the board; fellow Americans **#9 Channel Maker** and

#7 United should set decent early fractions.

Trying to get Arklow in the trifecta, I'll box him with my top two Euros (Magical and Mogul) in Ticket #8, which is a \$3 trifecta equaling an \$18 investment.

TIZ THE CLASSIC

I want so badly to pick Belmont Stakes (G1) and Travers Stakes (G1) winner **#2 Tiz the Law** in the Classic, but I am worried about his inside post; his best races have come when he has had open air to his outside. The horses who pose his biggest threats are the Whitney Stakes (G1) and Awesome Again Stakes (G1) winner **#8 Improbable** and the Stephen Foster Stakes (G2) winner **#4 Tom's d'Etat**. Ticket #9 starts off my Classic wagers by boxing those three in a \$4 trifecta box (\$24 total).

The race should unfold with Kentucky Derby (G1) winner **#9 Authentic** looking to clear the field and the Woodward Handicap (G1) victor **#7 Global Campaign** making it tough for him on his inside. The 2020 Pacific Classic Stakes (G1) champ **#10 Maximum Security** should track behind them, so jockey Manny Franco will need to extract Tiz the Law from the inside once these horses clear and get his horse some breathing room before setting up shop just behind them. Tom's d'Etat and Improbable will get cozy trips behind the leaders, too. Global Campaign may struggle with this distance and throw in the towel first, so the result will be decided by whether or not Authentic and Maximum Security both retreat.

My bet is that they will. Maximum Security looked like he was ready to go to the breeding shed after finishing a well-beaten second in the Awesome Again, though he's reportedly trained much better for the Classic. Authentic has run back-to-back tough races in the Kentucky Derby

and Preakness, so he should be hitting a wall soon. This will allow Tiz the Law, Improbable, and Tom's d'Etat a chance to take over late.

For Ticket #10, my final bet, I'll throw one closer into a \$1 trifecta box. I have to bet my boy, the Suburban Stakes (G2) winner **#1 Tacitus**, in this race. I'd cry if Tacitus hitting the board is why I don't hit this trifecta. He's always shown up in the biggest races, and at 20/1, maybe he'll come running late for a piece. Hey, it's 2020, the craziest year ever, so if tough luck Tacitus somehow ran big, wouldn't that be fitting?

OVERVIEW:

Superstars Serengeti Empress and Gamine will square off in this spot to kick off the Breeders' Cup action on Saturday. Both horses have elite front-end speed as their main weapon, so a pace meltdown is quite possible if they hook up early.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Gamine, Serengeti Empress*

Pressing Speed: *Inthemidstofbiz, Venetian Harbor*

Stalkers: *Sconsin, Speech*

Closers: *Bell's the One, Come Dancing, Sally's Curlin*

Most sprint races at this level are loaded with speed up front, and this one is no different. The showdown could be epic with Serengeti Empress and Gamine set to square off in a crazy speed duel.

TOP CHOICE: #7 SERENGETI EMPRESS

Look, there is no doubt on paper that we could see a pace duel for the ages develop, but what if Serengeti Empress is the "speed of the speed" and just runs them off their feet here? It's very possible that could be the case, and she has proven that she can go fast early and still stay on late. We'll roll the dice with her on top.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Speech, #2 Gamine, #9 Bell's the One

Speech should sit a nice stalking trip and get first run if/when the pace falls apart. Gamine must be respected based on her one-turn races. If she can run with Serengeti Empress early, then she has a shot to hold on for a piece of things. Bell's the One beat our top choice last time out and the pace should set up perfectly for her.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Come Dancing, #5 Sconsin, #8 Sally's Curlin

If the pace does indeed fall apart up front, these horses can pick up the pieces in the late stages. All have proven that they can win whether stalking or well off the leaders; they just need this pace to fall apart in front of them.

OTHERS: #4 Inthemidstofbiz, #6 Venetian Harbor

Inthemidstofbiz and Venetian Harbor both won prep races over this track last time out, but they might be a little outclassed in this spot. Their speed figures are just a small cut below the top horses in this spot.

OVERVIEW:

This looks like one of the more wide-open events of the Breeders' Cup once again this season. Trainer Peter Miller has won this 3 years in a row and has a longshot ready to make it 4, but he has to deal with several of the fastest thoroughbreds in the world.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Big Runner, Just Might, Into Mystic*

Pressing Speed: *Bombard, Leinster, Texas Wedge, Wildman Jack*

Stalkers: *Extravagant Kid, Front Run the Fed, Imprimis, Wet Your Whistle*

Closers: *Glass Slippers, Got Stormy, Oleksandra*

This event usually has a blazing pace. It's going to be more of the same this season with several gunners signed on to run.

TOP CHOICE: #3 IMPRIMIS

With so much speed signed on to run, the fast-closing Imprimis has our attention. He's crossed the wire first in both races this year, including a big win over this track in 2019. This is a completely wide-open affair, so he's worth taking a shot on top at 6/1.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Big Runner, #6 Glass Slippers, #7 Leinster, #8 Oleksandra, #12 Got Stormy, #14 Extravagant Kid

So many horses have a shot here that it's ridiculous. Each and every horse in this group could win this on their best day. Trips and pace are going to be important factors in this race, so you'll have to go deep in multi-race wagers if you want to feel safe about staying alive.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Front Run the Fed, #5 Wet Your Whistle, #11 Wildman Jack

Front Run the Fed comes into this race in very good form, finishing second to our top choice last time out. Wet Your Whistle won a Grade 3 at Belmont Park last time out in front-running fashion. Wildman Jack has run consistent races all season long.

OTHERS: #2 Just Might, #9 Into Mystic, #10 Bombard, #13 Texas Wedge

The most interesting horse in this group is Miller's Texas Wedge. He's been off form recently, but Miller has won this race too many times to think that he doesn't know what he's doing by now.

This race could have a fast pace with Knicks Go, War of Will, and Complexity doing their best running in the early stages of the race.

TOP CHOICE: #5 KNICKS GO

It's hard to believe how good Knicks Go has gotten under trainer Brad Cox. His track record-setting win here last time out is more than good enough to win this race, and a lot of his major competitors might not like this two-turn mile configuration. He also loves Keeneland, which is a big plus.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 War of Will, #7 Rushie, #8 Pirate's Punch, #10 Complexity

War of Will probably fits best in this race and is the class of the field. Rushie should excel at this distance and has run well at Keeneland in the past. Pirate's Punch has been ultra-consistent all season long. Complexity might be the most talented horse in the field, but he struggled when going two turns in the past.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Art Collector, #2 Sharp Samurai, #12 Owendale

Art Collector cuts back in distance while also dropping down in class. Sharp Samurai ran well over the dirt last time out and now he picks up Irad Ortiz Jr. to ride. Owendale could be the fastest one closing if there's a major pace meltdown.

It was super tough to pick against Rushing Fall; I've only done it one other time in her entire career. The distance seems like it might be a problem for her, unlike Audarya, who won a Group 1 event 2 starts back and nearly won another last time out, finishing a close third to our top pick in the BC Turf.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Sistercharlie, #4 Mean Mary, #6 Rushing Fall, #7 Terebellum

Sistercharlie can win this race with her top effort, but we haven't seen that side of her in over a year. Mean Mary and Rushing fall are very deserving of support and have to be played in this spot. Both horses have been tremendous all year long. Terebellum is the "other" European shipper who could be dangerous at a price.

With Vekoma out of the race, that has us leaning to the Steve Asmussen-trained Yaupon, who has been sensational in all 4 career starts. He might be a special type of horse and could give Asmussen back-to-back titles in this race.

MAJOR THREATS: #11 Diamond Oops, #2 C Z Rocket

Diamond Oops won the local prep race for this event and always seems to show up with a solid effort. C Z Rocket has won 5 straight since being claimed by trainer Peter Miller, who's won this twice. Will C Z Rocket pull off another miracle in this tougher spot?

Dunbar Road is the most likely upsetter in the field but she didn't run well last time out, a bit concerning as she steps up to face a pair of superstars. Swiss Skydiver has had one of the greatest 3-year-old seasons in a long time and is a Horse of the Year candidate with a win here.

Arklow and United are the most logical American horses with a chance and are coming into the race in great form. However, the European shippers really tower over this field. TOP CHOICE: #2 TIZ THE LAW

The post position draw is less than ideal, but Tiz the Law should be ready to fire one of the best races of his career. If he can get back to his Travers Stakes (G1) effort, then he will be in a great position to pull off the victory and most likely lock down Horse of the Year. It's all up to Manny Franco to work out a solid, clean trip.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 Tom's d'Etat, #8 Improbable, #10 Maximum Security

Tom's d'Etat was nearly our top pick, but despite his lengthy layoff, he is a must on all tickets. The Baffert duo of Improbable and Maximum Security must be respected. Both are more than capable of winning this event and Improbable looks like he's in the best form of his career.

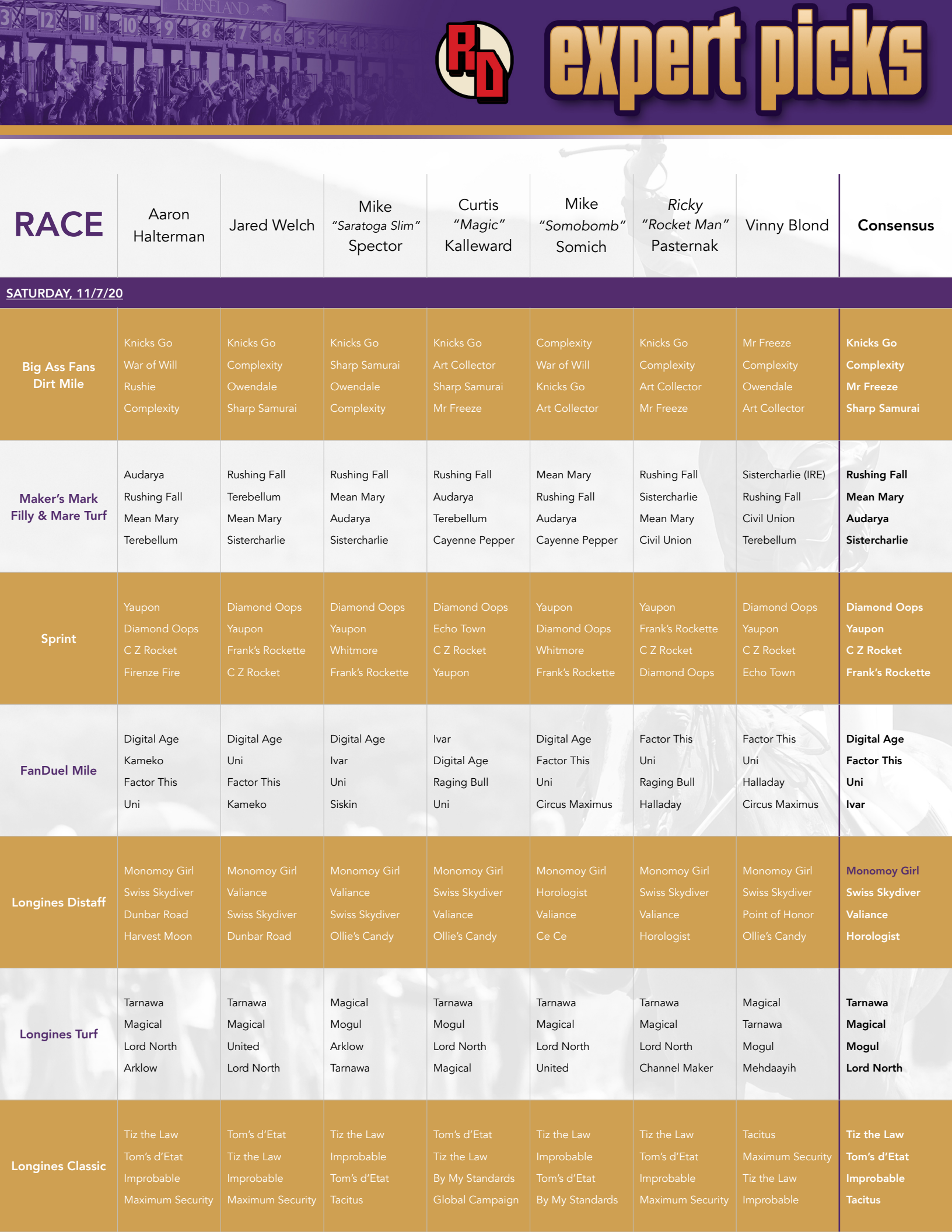
