FLEUR DE LIS STAKES (G2)

OVERVIEW:

This year's Fleur de Lis only drew a field of 6; however, that includes the top-ranked Letruska. She'll face a test from several up-and-coming horses, which makes this field very interesting from a betting prospective. This is a great way to kick off the stakes portion of the card.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Letruska*

Pressing Speed: *Envoutante*

Stalkers: *Antoinette, Spice Is Nice*

Closers: *Point of Honor, Vault*

It looks like Letruska will once again be the controlling speed in the race, which is not good news for the other horses. If she gets out to a nice early lead, she'll be very tough to run down.

TOP CHOICE: #6 LETRUSKA

There is no doubt this is the #1-ranked older female in the country after her victory in the Ogden Phipps Stakes (G1) last time out. If she shows up with that kind of effort, it'll be lights out for the rest of this field, and really any field she faces this season. The only question mark is the fact she's entered in this race out of the blue, as this did not seem to be the plan. Is she running back too quickly? We'll see on Saturday.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 Envoutante, #5 Spice Is Nice

Envoutante completely dominated lesser competition last year but has struggled when facing top-level horses in her crop. Spice Is Nice has always been a horse with a lot of hype. She might be ready to live up to that hype this season after 2 straight victories.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Point of Honor

This filly usually shows up with a good effort; however, it's been a while since we've seen her in the winners circle. She was able to hit the board in some major races last year, though, which means she can do the same here at a decent price.

OTHERS: #2 Antoinette, #3 Vault

Antoinette is probably better on the turf, which makes her hard to pick in this spot. Vault has won 2 straight; however, this spot looks to be much tougher than what she's faced in the past.

OVERVIEW:

The 3-year-old turf males take center stage in this event, which drew a solid field of eight. There is no real standout in this one, so you might have to go deep to survive this leg in all your multi-race wagers. This should be fun.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Helium, Next*

Pressing Speed: *Starrininmydreams, Dyn O Mite*

Stalkers: *Accredit, Royal Prince, El Kabong*

Closers: *In Effect*

It seems like they should be moving pretty quickly in this spot, with several speed horses signed on to run. A couple are making their turf debuts, which leads to a few question marks.

TOP CHOICE: #5 ROYAL PRINCE

After two straight wins, this horse moved up in class for the American Turf Stakes (G2), running a decent sixth in that spot. Last time out, he flattened out a bit going 1 1/8 miles, so this cut back to a mile seems to make a lot of sense. Trainer Brad Cox is always tough to beat at Churchill Downs in these types of race and his top rider Florent Geroux gets called back.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Accredit, #7 Helium, #8 Next

Both of Accredit's wins came on turf, including a victory over this track last time out. However, he is now a scratch. Helium makes his turf debut here after running against the best dirt horses in the crop. He also has 2 synthetic track victories, which is a good sign. Next runs second off the layoff and should improve.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 Starrininmydreams, #6 El Kabong

Starrininmydreams makes his turf debut and gets Jose Ortiz to ride. That is definitely a positive sign. El Kabong will look to make it 2 in a row after breaking his maiden over this track and at this distance last time out.

OTHERS: #3 In Effect, #4 Dyn O Mite

In Effect will need to improve from a speed figure standpoint to have any chance to compete with this group. Dyn O Mite must reverse his current form to have a shot.

OVERVIEW:

The most wide-open field on the entire card attracted a large field of 10 to run in the first 2-year-old fillies stakes of the year. Trainer Steve Asmussen has two solid runners in this race and both have shown solid early speed. Can anyone beat him here?

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Wicked Halo, Tizplenty*

Pressing Speed: *Cartel Queen, Mollie Kate, Ontheonesandtwos*

Stalkers: *Behave Virginia, Compressed Energy*

Closers: *Classiness, Catchusifyoucan, Mi Estrella*

This one should be pretty quick up front; however, since Asmussen trains the two fastest horses, don't look for them to knock heads with each other early.

TOP CHOICE: #1 WICKED HALO

She ships in from Lone Star Park after breaking her maiden on debut by 2 lengths. That race earned her the fastest Timeform figure of anyone in the race, and Asmussen wouldn't ship her in unless he was high on her. Jose Ortiz also picks up the mount for this race, which is a good sign leading into this race.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Cartel Queen, #3 Tizplenty, #8 Ontheonesandtwos

Cartel Queen has a small experience edge over this group, having 2 starts under her belt. However, she will be scratching. Tizplenty also has 2 races under belt, and her win for Asmussen looked very impressive. Ontheonesandtwos won professional on debut over this track last time out.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #6 Mollie Kate, #7 Behave Virginia

Mollie Kate was a nice winner on debut over this track, and while that race didn't come back with a fast figure, she at least won it with ease. Behave Virginia also dominated her competition on debut, but her speed figure didn't come back all that fast, either.

OTHERS: #4 Classiness, #5 Catchusifyoucan, #9 Compressed Energy, #10 Mi Estrella

At this time of year, it's never wise to write off any of the 2-year-olds. These horses look overmatched on paper but could easily improve this early in their careers.

OVERVIEW:

After the females showed their stuff, now it's the 2-year-old dudes' turns. The Bashford Manor is a staple of the Churchill Downs meet each year, with several runners usually moving on to Saratoga for more big races.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Lansdowne, Glacial*

Pressing Speed: *Tapped Off, Whatstheconnection*

Stalkers: *Vodka N Water, Whistlewhileyoumow, Double Thunder*

Closers: *Knocker Down, Red Run, Rising Outlaw, Shesgotattitude*

This is yet another event that looks to have a hot early pace. Most of these 2-year-old races produce some pretty fast fractions.

TOP CHOICE: #4 GLACIAL

He was one of the more impressive 2-year-olds to debut at Churchill Downs this meet. The son of Frosted went off at odds of 7/1 on his first race and faced an experienced horse that was a 2/5 favorite, but he still flew by that runner in the stretch for a 2 1/2-length score. He has a right to show improvement in this spot and the small stretch out in distance should only help him.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Vodka N Water, #8 Double Thunder, #9 Red Run

Vodka N Water is still a maiden, but he ran well against our top pick last time out and gets Jose Ortiz to ride. Double Thunder was a solid debut winner at Monmouth Park who might improve with the use of the whip. Red Run won nicely over this track on debut.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 Lansdowne, #11 Shesgotattitude

Lansdowne was impressive on debut, winning in gate to wire fashion over this track. The filly Shesgotattitude was a nice winner at Keeneland on debut before finishing fourth against boys in the Kentucky Juvenile Stakes over this race track last time out.

OTHERS: #3 Tapped Off, #5 Whatstheconnection, #6 Knocked Down, #7 Whistlewhileyoumow, #10 Rising Outlaw

As stated in the other race, it's always tough to write off 2-year-olds this early in their careers. These looked overmatched in this spot, but they could improve at the drop of a hat this time of year.

We're back on the turf for this event, which a solid field of 10 runners. Somelikeithotbrown headlines the field, fresh off a victory last time out at Pimlico in the Dinner Party Stakes (G2). He'll take on several solid local horses who will present a challenge.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Somelikeithotbrown*

Pressing Speed: *Mutakatif, Field Pass*

Stalkers: *Kentucky Ghost*

Closers: *Set Piece, Super Sol, Hierarchy, Ride a Comet, Spooky Channel, In Love*

It sure looks like Somelikeithotbrown should be all alone on the lead in this spot. If that happens, he'll be near impossible to run down in the stretch.

TOP CHOICE: #3 SOMELIKEITHOTBROWN

He comes into this race hot after winning the Dinner Party with ease last time out. The pace setup here looks picture-perfect; one of the only horses who might go with him early is from the same trainer, so it's likely gets an easy trip and proves ultra-tough to run down.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Set Piece, #7 Ride a Comet, #8 Field Pass

Set Piece comes into this hot after winning 2 straight, both over this track. He looms as the best chance to beat the favorite. Ride a Comet can win this event on his best day, but he's a bit inconsistent. Field Pass takes a nice class drop for this one.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Super Sol, #9 Spooky Channel

Super Sol won in his turf debut last time out, defeating allowance horses at 44/1, and might be tough again here. Spooky Channel is capable of competing with this group on his best day, though he might be better in longer races.

OTHERS: #2 Mutakatif, #5 Hierarchy, #6 Kentucky Ghost, #10 In Love

On their best days, these horses have a shot, but they just looked to be a bit overmatched against this very tough top-heavy field.

STEPHEN FOSTER STAKES (G2)

OVERVIEW:

The main event is here! The Stephen Foster is always one of the highlights of the spring racing season at Churchill Downs. In fact, once you take out the big races on Kentucky Oaks and Kentucky Derby days, it's probably the most recognizable race at the track. The winner earns a free entry into the Breeders' Cup Classic at Del Mar.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Sprawl, Warrior's Charge*

Pressing Speed: *Maxfield, Visitant*

Stalkers: *Empty Tomb, Necker Island, Silver Dust*

Closers: *Chess Chief, South Bend*

The pace won't be overly fast here, which will give Warrior's Charge the chance to take this field gate to wire. Maxfield has enough speed to stay in range, though, so the pace setup shouldn't worry the favorite.

TOP CHOICE: #8 MAXFIELD

Simply put, if he shows up with his best effort, expect him to dominate here. He's defeated many of these horses in the past and the new challengers leave a lot to be desired. There's no need for a long reason why he'll win.

Just show up with your race, Maxfield, and you'll beat these guys. You're the most likely winner on the entire card.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Silver Dust, #6 Warrior's Charge

Silver Dust is inconsistent, but his best effort gives him an outside shot. Warrior's Charge has not run well lately; however, he looks to have a major pace advantage in this spot.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Chess Chief, #2 Empty Tomb

Chess Chief usually run up for third in races at this level. He can do more of the same today; however, hitting the board is likely to be his ceiling. Empty Tomb comes into this race hot, while he has a running style that will give him a shot in this spot.

OTHERS: #3 Necker Island, #4 Sprawl, #7 South Bend, #9 Visitant

Out of this group, Necker Island could be the most dangerous. He won nicely last time out and this will be his third start off the layoff.

The Tepin rounds out this awesome card and serves as the last race of the Churchill Downs meet this season. It's quite the race to end on as well, with 13 evenly-matched 3-year-old fillies lined up to run.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Bullseye Beauty, Adventuring, New Boss*
Pressing Speed: *Sylvia Q, Navratilova, Malloy*
Stalkers: *Town Avenger*
Closers: *Invincible Gal, Fairchild, Tobys Heart, Commanders Palace, Barista, Arm Candy*

Nobody in this race is a real speed-burner; however, several like to go to the lead early. The pace should be sharp enough, especially with a full field.

TOP CHOICE: #1 INVINCIBLE GAL

This was one of the hardest races to pick a winner. In the end, the pace should set up very well for Invincible Gal, who should be ready for a peak effort after knocking the rust off last time out. She also gets jockey Jose Ortiz, who has several quality mounts on the card. If we see any improvement at all from her, which we should, then she will be tough to hold off down the stretch.

MAJOR THREATS: #4 Town Avenger, #7 Adventuring, #8 Tobys Heart

Town Avenger has plenty of upside after breaking her maiden on debut last time out. Adventuring finally gets to the turf, which is what they've wanted to do with her all along. Tobys Heart won a similar race two starts back at Keeneland.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Fairchild, #11 Commanders Palace, #12 Barista

Fairchild broke his maiden at Keeneland on the turf 2 starts back. Commanders Palace was a solid maiden special weight winner over this track last time out. Barista has an experience edge over this rest of this group but hasn't won yet this year.

OTHERS: #2 Sylvia Q, #5 Navratilova, #6 Bullseye Beauty, #9 Malloy, #10 New Boss, #13 Arm Candy

There are several from this group that could jump up and make an impact in this spot. This is one of the best betting races on the card.
