RACE 3:

WOLF HILL STAKES

OVERVIEW:

It's always fun watching these turf sprint events. This is a deep and evenly-matched group going 5.5 furlongs in a race that could produce a sharp price. Turf sprint stakes have historically produced nice payouts at Monmouth Park and the "no whip" rules at Monmouth have made things unpredictable at times.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *The Critical Way, I Got A Rock*

Pressing Speed: *Fox Rox, Readyforprimetime*

Stalkers: *Mojovation*

Closers: *Cajun Casanova, The Connector*

Turf sprints will always produce fast paces and this race is no different. However, the key to winning most of these is playing horses who can carry their early speed. Don't be afraid to play speed horses

TOP CHOICE: #1 THE CRITICAL WAY

He's been the most consistent horse of the bunch, earning high speed figures in each of his starts. He also won last time out by a widening 3 lengths in the local prep event for this. Many of the same horses he defeated return here, which is a good sign for his chances to pick up another victory. This horse has hit the board in 8 straight starts as well.

MAJOR THREATS: #7 Readyforprimetime

His early speed gives him a shot and he's faced some tough runners lately. He'll be hard-pressed to beat the big favorite but is the logical alternative.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #6 Fox Rox

This horse is coming off of an allowance win over this track, which is always important. He was no match for our top choice 2 starts back but seems like the logical horse to use underneath the big favorite.

OTHERS: #2 Mojovation, #3 I Got A Rock, #4 Cajun Casanova, #5 The Connector

It's hard to see any of these making an impact in this spot. You want early speed in these types of races, something most of these are lacking.

WINSTAR MATCHMAKER STAKES (G3)

OVERVIEW:

The older fillies and mares take center stage in this 1 1/8-mile turf event. Over the years, we've learned to look for Chad Brown-trained horses in these types of events, and he entered four here. However, with other solid options facing his stable here, this should be fun to watch unfold.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Juliet Foxtrot*

Pressing Speed: *Always Shopping, Counterparty Risk*

Stalkers: *Nay Lady Nay*

Closers: *Great Island, No Mercy Percy, California Queen*

They won't be flying in this race, but for a turf route, this won't be the slowest pace you'll ever see. A few in here can be on or near the lead, which might help the closers coming from out of it.

TOP CHOICE: #5 JULIET FOXTROT

There is no doubt she is the most consistent horse in this race and has put up the fastest speed figures. She gets away from Churchill Downs, the track where she struggles the most, so that's a positive. She also has an early pace edge over her main rivals, giving her a good shot to take this field gate to wire.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Great Island, #3 Counterparty Risk

Great Island will try to bounce back after a poor effort last time out and picks up Joel Rosario to ride, a major bonus. Counterparty Risk is a consistent runner who'll likely come with a strong run down the lane, but is now a late scratch from the race.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #1 Always Shopping, #7 California Queen

Always Shopping had a great meet at Gulfstream Park but has struggled since leaving that track. This race is a nice drop in class for her. California Queen, the third Brown, comes into this race off of a victory and gets Flavien Prat to ride. Prat and Brown win often together.

OTHERS: #4 No Mercy Percy, #6 Nay Lady Nay

This group just looks to be a bit outclassed against a field that came up tough for this level. Several high-quality runners entered this race.

MONMOUTH CUP STAKES (G3)



OVERVIEW:

The older male division continues to dominate the racing scene in this country. Several horses considered "second level" types will run in this spot, trying to jump up into the elite category with a win here. Many of the country's top barns are represented, so it's possible that we see a breakout performance.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Justinthenickotime*

Pressing Speed: *Ny Traffic, Dr Post*

Stalkers: *Night Ops*

Closers: *Bankit, Bal Harbour*

There isn't a ton of early speed in this one, but there's enough to think that nobody will get an easy lead on the front end. We shouldn't see overly fast fractions, though, especially with a shorter field.

TOP CHOICE: #4 NY TRAFFIC

It's hard to believe that he lost his last local start despite looking like a winner at the top of the stretch. The lack of the whip seemed to confuse him, as he idled a bit after striking the front. The hope is that he learned something from his first experience over this oval without a whip and will be better for it in this bigger race. He's the most talented horse in the field.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Dr Post, #6 American Dubai, #7 Bankit

Dr Post adds blinkers after a poor showing in the Met Mile (G1). American Dubai has been solid since moving to the Robertino Diodoro barn and should set the pace, but is now scratched. Bankit always shows up with a consistent effort, but his chances of winning will depend on the pace.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Night Ops

Night Ops consistently runs well in these types of spots, which makes him interesting here. He's not at the level of the top horses in this division, but he always seems to have a say in things against fields like this.

OTHERS: #1 Bal Harbour, #2 Justinthenickotime

Bal Harbour has seen better days. He could still win with his best effort, but we haven't seen that from him lately. Justinthenickotime has won 2 in a row but moves way up in class.

MOLLY PITCHER STAKES (G3)

OVERVIEW:

The Molly Pitcher is a staple of the Haskell Day card. Superstars like Midnight Bisou have won past runnings, which shows the strength of this event. We don't have a major standout in this year's group, but several are looking to make a name for themselves, which means price potential.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Bank Sting, Graceful Princess*

Pressing Speed: *Bajan Girl, Mrs. Danvers*

Stalkers: *Our Super Freak, Water White*

Closers: *Vault, Thankful, Reina La Kelsy*

A few can go to the front early, with a couple more willing to press the lead or sit just off the pace, but none are real speed burners. Don't expect a fast pace.

TOP CHOICE: #3 VAULT

Can she rebound from a very poor performance in the Fleur de Lis Stakes (G2) at Churchill Downs? Before that, she won 2 in a row including the Ruffian Stakes (G2) at Belmont Park. The pace seems like it will be decent enough to set up well for her late-running style.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Our Super Freak, #5 Bank Sting

Our Super Freak could pull off a mild upset in this spot. She's hit the board in 3 straight starts. Bank Sting has won 4 straight coming into this event but must move up in class, which is her big question mark.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 Mrs. Danvers

We'll see if the "good" Mrs. Danvers shows up to make a race of it. At her best, she can compete with this group, but she's very inconsistent. We also haven't seen her best effort in her last few starts, which adds to the worry.

OTHERS: #4 Thankful, #6 Bajan Girl, #7 Water White, #8 Reina La Kelsy, #9 Graceful Princess

This group just seems a bit too inconsistent to back in this spot. Thankful is a little interesting, but it's more about the powerful connections (Todd Pletcher and Flavien Prat) on her side.

UNITED NATIONS STAKES (G1)



OVERVIEW:

The second-biggest race of the Monmouth Park meet and the other Grade 1 event contested on the Jersey Shore, this race drew a competitive group of runners ready to test their abilities in this turf route showdown. Will anyone use this as a springboard to bigger things?

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Epic Bromance, Winters Back, Tribhuvan*
Pressing Speed: *Imperador, Glynn County, Oceans Map*
Stalkers: *Arklow*
Closers: *Serve the King, Fantasio, Master Piece*

Surprisingly, this turf route event seems to have a lot of speed signed on. Closers might have a big advantage, though some quality front-runners could be hard to pass.

TOP CHOICE: #8 MASTER PIECE

He catches an easier spot than what he faced in recent stakes attempts. Last time out, he had zero pace to run into, which hurt his chances, but this race should be the opposite. Joel Rosario also gets back aboard; he won on him 2 starts back and his riding style fits this horse well.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Arklow, #6 Winters Back, #10 Tribhuvan

Arklow is very classy and has won 2 straight coming into this. Winters Back was second last time out in the local prep race. He should improve this time around. Tribhuvan ran second in the ultra-tough Manhattan Stakes (G1) last time out.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Serve the King, #9 Glynn County

Serve the King runs consistently well at this level and hit the board in 3 of his last 4 starts. Glynn County jumps up in class for this event, but his trainer Mike Maker is tough in turf routes.

OTHERS: #2 Epic Bromance, #4 Imperador, #5 Fantasio, #7 Oceans Map

It will be hard for anyone in this group to make an impact in what is another tough event. Several of the top horses are deserving of Grade 1 status.

TVG.COM HASKELL STAKES (G1)

OVERVIEW:

The main event is here! The Haskell is always the highlight of the Monmouth Park racing season. In fact, it really has become one of the marquee races for 3-year-olds every year. This field is no different, with several quality runners entered. The winner earns a free entry into the Breeders' Cup Classic at Del Mar as well.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Following Sea, Hot Rod Charlie*

Pressing Speed: *Mandaloun, Midnight Bourbon*

Stalkers: *Pickin' Time, Antigravity*

Closers: *Basso*

On paper, this one should be fast, Hot Rod Charlie and Midnight Bourbon are proven front-runners at this level and Following Sea has shown great speed in sprints; he should be a factor up front as well.

TOP CHOICE: #4 HOT ROD CHARLIE

We'll see if he can run back to his amazing Belmont Stakes (G1) runner-up effort that spot was good enough to win many past Belmonts. He progressed in each start this season while showing great consistency, which gives confidence that'll he show up with a nice effort here.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Following Sea, #3 Mandaloun

Following Sea was fantastic in his last 2 races, winning easily at Oaklawn and Belmont Park. If he can get the distance, then he'll be tough here. Mandaloun won the local prep last time out, which is important this year because of the no-whip rule at Monmouth.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #6 Midnight Bourbon

Midnight Bourbon has been consistent his entire career. We know he'll show up with a solid effort, as he's hit the board in all of his starts outside of the Kentucky Derby (G1). He'll be hanging around at the end with a chance.

OTHERS: #2 Antigravity, #5 Pickin' Time, #7 Basso

Simply put, if any of these make an impact in this race, then it'll be a massive surprise. They look overmatched in this spot.

We can't do a guide on opening weekend of Saratoga without throwing in some races from the Spa! The Sanford kicks off the stakes actions for 2-year-old males and is sure to produce prospects worth watching as the year progresses. This should be a fun field to follow.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Headline Report, Due Vini*

Pressing Speed: *Trust Our Journey, Maryland Brando, Candy Landing, Dance Code*

Stalkers: *Seize the Night, Lucago, Kavod, Catch the Smoke*

Closers: *Ottoman Empire, Wit*

All of the 2-year-old races at Saratoga produce fast paces; expect nothing different here. This early in their careers, they just show speed early and try to hang on late.

TOP CHOICE: #9 HEADLINE REPORT

We all know that trainer Wesley Ward is great at training 2-year-olds. This one was especially impressive in his debut, defeating a quality field of maiden special weight runners at Belmont Park. He showed good early speed but didn't look like the type that has to have the early lead to succeed. If he takes a step forward off of that effort, then he'll be tough to beat in this spot.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Wit, #7 Ottoman Empire, #11 Seize the Night

Wit looked great on debut for the powerful Todd Pletcher barn. Ottoman Empire was one of the more impressive debut winners at the Churchill Downs meet. Seize the Night was a sharp winner on debut for Dallas Steward, breaking his maiden at Churchill Downs by a head.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #2 Candy Landing, #6 Maryland Brando

Candy Landing was impressive on debut, breaking his maiden with ease in a maiden special weight at Churchill Downs. Maryland Brando won by over 11 lengths on debut at Delaware Park. We'll see if he can bring his form to the NYRA circuit.

OTHERS: #3 Catch the Smoke, #4 Trust Our Journey, #5 Dance Code, #8 Due Vini, #10 Kavod, #12 Lucago

Trust Our Journey was a well-beaten third in the Tremont Stakes last timeout and Kavod was a distant second. Due Vini was a winner on debut but now must move up in class. Lucago won a maiden claiming race at Gulfstream Park in his last start.

Trainer Chad Brown has won this race 5 years in a row and has a solid hand once again this year, but his barn will be challenged by a very difficult field. This is a hell of a way to kick off the Grade 1 action at Saratoga!

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Summer Romance*

Pressing Speed: *Vigilantes Way*

Stalkers: *Harvey's Lil Goil, Lemista*

Closers: *Althiqa, La Signare, Magic Attitude, Pocket Square*

Summer Romance looks to have an easy lead in this spot, as all the other horses show their best in the later stages of the race.

TOP CHOICE: #2 POCKET SQUARE

We'll see if she can bounce back in this spot after a poor effort last time out in the Just a Game Stakes (G1) at Belmont Park. She was our top pick that day, so it was extra disappointing when she came up empty down the stretch. Brown believes that she's coming into this race in better shape, though, so it wouldn't be shocking to see her give Brown his sixth straight victory in this race.

MAJOR THREATS: #6 Summer Romance, #7 Lemista, #8 Althiqa

Summer Romance should get the perfect shot to take the field gate to wire. Althiqa won the Just a Game during her debut in the United States. Lemista was second in her United States debut and could improve off of that effort, which puts her right in the mix.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #5 Harvey's Lil Goil

Harvey's Lil Goil is very classy on the turf but must bounce back from a poor effort last time out. She gets a cut back in distance and will run over what is hopefully a firm turf course. She's proven that her talent level is high enough to compete here.

OTHERS: #1 La Signare, #3 Magic Attitude, #4 Vigilantes Way

There is nothing wrong with these three, but this field is one of the toughest you'll find in 2021. It will take a peak effort for them to have a shot.
