It's always fun to watch **#3 Jackie's Warrior** run; however, he will be too short of a price to bet to win. So, we'll pair him in a straight exacta with **#5 Cody's Wish**, who has looked solid in his last few races.

Can we get a half-way decent price on **#6 Jack Christopher** in this spot? He is 6/5 on the morning line, which seems more than fair, as he cuts back in distance for this race. His normal effort is good enough to beat this group, so hopefully we get the right price.

Race #9: PERSONAL ENSIGN STAKES

Jared likes **#1 Letruska** and Aaron likes **#3 Clairiere**, so we'll play these in a straight exacta. We will play Letruska on top because if Clairiere wins this will not pay much at all. Hopefully Letruska can wire the field.

OVERVIEW:

Some of the stakes races on this card could be a little chalky, but this one looks to be a bit more wide open, which is always a good thing for the bettors. Maybe we can create some value in this spot.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Technical Analysis*

Pressing Speed: *Lemista*

Stalkers: *Our Flash Drive*

Closers: *Fluffy Socks, High Opinion*

Turf races on this circuit usually have slow paces and this one should be no different. Front runners should have the advantage and Technical Analysis could be on the lead alone.

TOP CHOICE: #5 TECHNICAL ANALYSIS

The pace sets up perfectly for her in this spot, with a short field and no other rival with enough speed to press her early. If that happens, she is going to be very difficult to beat, while she also drops down in class in a big way today after taking on tougher Grade 1 company last time out. Her 3 prior efforts this season are most likely all good enough to get the job done against this group, as the horses that have beaten her would be favored here.

MAJOR THREATS: #2 Lemista, #4 Fluffy Socks

Lemista goes for 2 straight victories today after an impressive win at Monmouth Park last time out. Fluffy Socks was second to Lemista in that spot, and seems to always be around at the end with a chance.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Our Flash Drive

She'll look to make it 2 in a row in this spot after a solid victory last time out over this track against lesser company. That race was good enough to compete today and she seems to be improving with each start.

OTHERS: #1 High Opinion

Any of these 5 can win in this spot; however, we just couldn't figure out a way to this one involved. From a pace standpoint, she looks to be up against it today.

OVERVIEW:

It's always a pleasure to watch Jackie's Warrior run. He's easily the best sprinter in the country, and like usual this year, he doesn't face much competition. That's a bummer from a betting perspective, but he's still fun to watch.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: Jackie's Warrior

Pressing Speed: Pipeline, Kneedeepinsnow

Stalkers: Three Two Zone, Baby Yoda

Closers: Drafted, Cody's Wish

The pace should not be blazing in this spot, which helps the heavy favorite that much more. Even if it gets fast up front, Jackie's Warrior still should be ok, as he showed last time out that he could sit off the pace.

TOP CHOICE: #3 JACKIE'S WARRIOR

Simply put, this horse is just a complete monster. After being crowned the top sprinter in the country last season, Jackie's Warrior has returned in style this year, winning 4 races in a row with ease. He's never lost at Saratoga and goes for his record 6th Grade 1 victory over this track. He's the fastest horse in the race early but is tactical to be the fastest horse in the race late, too.

MAJOR THREATS: #5 Cody's Wish, #6 Pipeline

Cody's Wish has won 2 straight races heading into this event: a stakes last time out at Churchill Downs and a graded stakes victory 2 starts back at Belmont Park. Pipeline cuts back in distance after running a good second behind his stablemate last time out at Monmouth Park.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #7 Kneedeepinsnow

This horse is ultra-consistent and should enjoy the distance. However, he seems to be more of a grinder, so he'll need a nice pace setup to have a shot to win it all. He was second to Jackie's Warrior last time out.

OTHERS: #1 Baby Yoda #2 Drafted, #4 Three Two Zone

This group looks to be a bit slow from a speed figure standpoint. However, this is the Graveyard of Champions, so perhaps something funky will happen.

OVERVIEW:

The Jerkens is always one of the most exciting races at Saratoga. Last year's running may have been the race of the year after Life Is Good and Jackie's Warrior engaged in an epic duel. This year's could be just as special.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

Pure Speed: *Conagher*

Pressing Speed: *Jack Christopher*

Stalkers: *Accretive, Actuator, Gunite*

Closers: *Happy Jack, Howling Time, Runninsonofagun, Totalizer*

With the presence of Conagher, the pace will be fast, and we know Jack Christopher will be just behind. These two will make it fast early, but will it matter?

TOP CHOICE: #6 JACK CHRISTOPHER

We should see this guy back in the winner's circle today as he cuts back in distance after trying the Haskell Stakes (G1) last time out and finishing third. He looked like he was going to win as they turned for home; however, he flattened out late. That showed that he is not a two-turn horse, but wow, has he been breathtaking at one turn. This is a solid group he faces today, but he is clearly the one to beat.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Conagher, #8 Gunite, #9 Accretive

Conagher is the main contender to the favorite in this spot as he also has been flawless when racing in one-turn events. Gunite has won 2 in a row including the local prep for this one, where he held off Accretive. Both return with shots at hitting the board.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #4 Actuator

He cuts back in distance after taking home the Indiana Derby (G3) last time out in impressive fashion. The second-place finisher came back to win, which shows that the field was decent. His only race at this distance was an impressive victory.

OTHERS: #2 Runninsonofagun, #3 Howling Time, #5 Happy Jack, #7 Totalizer

This race looks to be pretty top-heavy, which is not a good sign for this group of horses. Any of them making an impact in this race would be a major surprise.

OVERVIEW:

We'll see if the defending champion Letruska can bounce back from a poor effort last time out to win this race for the second straight season. She'll have to turn the tables on Clairiere, who comes into this race as the top older female in training.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

Pure Speed: *Letruska*

Pressing Speed: *Search Results*

Stalkers: *Malathaat*

Closers: *Clairiere, Crazy Beautiful*

Letruska will look to take this field gate to wire for the second straight year, and should have a shot at doing so, but Search Results will likely press her a bit. It won't be blazing, but she should be decent in this spot.

TOP CHOICE: #3 CLAIRIERE

We'll see if the Steve Asmussen trainee can keep the winning streak going today after two stylish wins in tough races on the NYRA circuit. She has soundly defeated all of her fellow rivals in this spot this year, with horse only loss coming to Letruska in the Apple Blossom at Oaklawn Park. If Letruska is pressed by Search Results early on in the race once again it will set up perfectly for Clairiere.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Letruska, #2 Search Results

Letruska was the champion last season; however, she has not been as brilliant this year. She comes into this race off of a non-effort at Belmont Park in the Ogden Phipps Stakes (G1). Search Results is the other major pace presence in the race. Last time out she dominated the Molly Pitcher Stakes (G3) at Monmouth Park.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #5 Malathaat

As much as everyone wants this horse to be a champion, she just hasn't been able to get it done, while it's hard to see that changing today. She is consistent, though, and should be around at the end with a chance.

OTHERS: #4 Crazy Beautiful

This filly is pretty solid overall, but just not quite good enough to compete with this group today. She probably needs a good drop in class.

RESORTS WORLD CASINO SWORD DANCER STAKES (G1)

OVERVIEW:

This has been a wide-open division all year long, which gives us an opportunity to find a price in this spot. There are several talented horses signed on to run in this spot; however, there is no real standout in this race.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: Tribhuvan

Pressing Speed: Channel Maker, Cross Border

Stalkers: Mira Mission, Cold Hard Cash

Closers: Adhamo, Broome, Gufo, Rockemperor, Soldier Rising

We've seen this before with Tribhuvan taking advantage of slow NYRA turf paces. He'll have a shot to do it again today, with very little pace other than himself.

TOP CHOICE: #3 BROOME

The European invader adds intrigue to a division that has left a lot to be desired so far this year. If he shows up with the sort of effort that he showed last year at the Breeders' Cup, then the rest of these are likely running for second. This year, he has been decent in three starts overseas, including a victory 2 starts back at Royal Ascot in a Group 2 stakes contested at this distance.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Adhamo, #5 Rockemperor, #6 Gufo

Adhamo has been a consistent runner since showing up in the United States. Rockemperor always shows up with a solid effort and will be running down the lane. The same could be said for Gufo; however, both of these horses have trouble finishing the job.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #9 Channel Maker

There is no doubt this guy can compete at this level when at his best; however, you never know which horse is going to show up from start to start. If he shows up with his mind on business, then he will have a say in the early pace and could be hard to pass in the stretch.

OTHERS: #2 Cross Border, #4 Cold Hard Cash, #8 Soldier Rising, #7 Tribhuvan, #10 Mira Mission

Out of all the day's stakes races, this one looks to be the most wide-open of them all, so don't be surprised if someone from this group jumps up and makes an impact in the race.

OVERVIEW:

The main event of the meet is finally here! This is always a major race, this year being no different, with the winner most likely becoming the top 3-year-old in the country going into the Breeders' Cup.

RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

Pure Speed: *Early Voting*

Pressing Speed: *Cyberknife*

Stalkers: *Artorius, Epicenter*

Closers: *Ain't Life Grand, Gilded Age, Rich Strike, Zandon*

There doesn't look to be too much pace in this year's running of the race, which will make the front runners tough in this spot. Closers could be compromised.

TOP CHOICE: #6 EPICENTER

Simply put, it is time for Epicenter to get the job done in a Grade 1 race. He's shown up with solid efforts in lower graded races; however, just missed in both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness Stakes. This is a race that his name written all over it, though, especially after a dominant victory in the Jim Dandy Stakes over this track. He is training beautifully leading up to the race as well, so this should be the day he gets that elusive Grade 1 score.

MAJOR THREATS: #1 Cyberknife, #7 Early Voting, #8 Zandon

Cyberknife looks for two great races a in a row after winning the Haskell Stakes last time out. However, the Haskell/Travers double is difficult to accomplish. Early Voting must rebound from a poor effort in the Jim Dandy Stakes, but should have a pace advantage. Zandon always seems to show up with a solid effort.

LONGSHOTS TO USE: #3 Ain't Life Grand, #5 Artorius

Ain't Life Grand ships in from Iowa after a solid win in the Iowa Derby. He should like this distance. Artorius looks to move up in class after an impressive win in the Curlin Stakes last time out over this track.

OTHERS: #2 Rich Strike, #4 Gilded Age

Rich Strike looks to prove that the Kentucky Derby was no fluke but must rebound from a poor effort in the Belmont Stakes. Gilded Age is getting better with each race; however, he seems to be a bit overmatched here.


