

# LIVE BANKROLL PLAYS

WITH THE RACING DUDES OWN  
AARON HALTERMAN  
& JARED WELCH

It's time for the first major horse racing event of 2021 and the Dudes are ready! This year, Aaron and Jared are giving out their EXACT race-by-race wagering plans for each of the seven stakes races on the card. There are nine total wagers spread throughout the stakes races. You can play these tickets exactly or take their opinions and sprinkle in your own thoughts. The Dudes have a \$300 budget, but make sure that you don't bet more than you can afford to lose.

Let's not waste any more time. Here's the Dudes' wagering plan for this year's seven stakes on Pegasus World Cup day.

## Race #4: FRED W. HOOPER STAKES

**#1 Performer** seems like a lock, so we won't get crazy. He drops down in class to a level where he's been dominant and the rest of this field leaves a lot to be desired. We'll keep it simple with a win wager.

## Race #7: MARSHUA'S RIVER STAKES

The action really heats up with this race, which could go a lot of different ways. Overall, we're not confident in any one horse in this spot, so we decided on a 4-horse trifecta box for \$1.

**#4 Vigilantes Way** is probably the strongest play in the race. We nearly keyed her on top, but we just liked a few others in the race too much to do that.

Jared loves **#1 Belle Laura** and her 12/1 morning line is very intriguing, so we definitely want to include her.

We also worked in **#6 Evil Lyn**, who might be the class of the field and will likely set the early pace.

**#8 Tuned** adds a lot of value in the underneath spots and should be closing late to pick up a minor award.

## Race #8: LA PREVOYANTE STAKES

This definitely feels like a race where anything can happen. Our top choices are **#1 Always Shopping** and **#12 Court Return**, so we're going to key them both in a \$1 trifecta and spend a total of just \$12 in this race, the lowest of any stakes on the card.

We're also adding **#7 Heavenly Curlin** and **#8 Delta's Kingdom**, who should both love this distance. Overall, this is a super tough race, so we just decided to take a small swing here and move on the next.

## Race #9: INSIDE INFORMATION STAKES

We won't get too creative here: **#2 Cinnabunny** is a very strong play. She struggled last time out, but we expect a big rebound in this spot. If she breaks well and gets to the lead, then there will be no catching her. Hopefully, her poor effort last time out gives us a little better price here.

## Race #10: W. L. McKNIGHT STAKES

This is a fantastic betting race, perhaps the best one on the card. Aaron likes **#7 Tide of the Sea** on top at a juicy 10/1 on the morning line, while Jared feels strongly about **#1 Doswell**. With that in mind, we singled those two on top in a trifecta.

We included **#4 Temple** and **#11 Channel Cat** in the second spot. Both should run well at this distance, especially Channel Cat, who always seems to hit the board in races like this.

In the third spot, we threw in **#5 Sadler's Joy** and **#6 Sir Sahib**. Both horses will be moving well late and have every opportunity to grab a piece of things.

Finally, at that 10/1 price, it's too tempting not to put a few bucks to win on Tide of the Sea. He could be a very nice cash if he goes off anywhere near that number, regardless of what else happens.

## Race #11: PEGASUS WORLD CUP TURF

This race is wide open, yet Jared and Aaron landed on the same horse on top: **#8 Anothertwistafate**. A \$20 win wager feels like a must.

Each half of the duo also landed on the same price horse, **#2 Breaking the Rules**, who offers too much value to ignore. He could make some serious noise here, so a \$10 exacta box is the logical play.

## Race #12: PEGASUS WORLD CUP

Aaron is a perfect 4-for-4 when it comes to picking the winner of the Pegasus World Cup, but he hasn't had as much luck in the exotics. Both Jared and Aaron landed on **#4 Knicks Go** on top, and after a ton of healthy debate, the duo decided that a win wager on him is the way to go.

Past Knicks Go, this race turns into a mess. If he doesn't win, it really opens the door for several others, which will make cashing a trifecta or superfecta wager extremely tricky. That's the main reason we tried to keep it very simple in this spot. Go, Knicks Go!

That brings us to \$310 in total bets, nearly dead-on to our intended \$300 budget. If you followed our Breeders' Cup bets, we ended with a bankroll of \$860, so let's reinvest the \$300+ winnings today and hope for some luck!

# RACE 4:

1 MILE (DIRT)  
4-YEAR-OLDS & UP  
\$125,000

## FRED W. HOOPER STAKES [G3]

### OVERVIEW:

The Fred Hooper kicks off the stakes action on the card with a competitive field of 8. Performer stands out on top, but strong local runners Phat Man, Shivaree, and Haikal could all take down the favorite.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Shivaree*

**Pressing Speed:** *Performer*

**Stalkers:** *Dream Maker, Phat Man, Avant Garde*

**Closers:** *Eye of a Jedi, Haikal, Indimaaj*

The pace shouldn't be overly fast, with Shivaree and Performer the only ones to likely show early speed. Neither should get into a big pace duel with the other.

### TOP CHOICE: #1 PERFORMER

It's exciting to see Performer making his 2021 debut in this spot. Hopefully he can stay healthy, which is something he has not been able to do in the past. He has always shown a major amount of talent, though, winning 5 of 7 starts. He must bounce back from a third-place showing in the Cigar Mile (G1), but this field looks much weaker.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #3 Shivaree, #5 Phat Man, #7 Haikal

Shivaree returned to the winner's circle last time out at Tampa Bay Downs, winning a small state-bred stakes event. He will be the speed of the field. The defending champion Phat Man always gives a strong effort at Gulfstream Park. Haikal runs second off the layoff here and will be closing strongly in the late stages.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #2 Eye of a Jedi, #6 Avante Garde

Eye of a Jedi ran a good second in the local Harlan's Holiday (G3) last time out. Avante Garde jumps back up to stakes company after 2 straight starter allowance wins.

**OTHERS:** #4 Dream Maker, #8 Indimaaj

Dream Maker switches back to dirt, which doesn't seem to be his best surface. Indimaaj enters this race with 2 straight victories against lesser company.

**BET TO WIN:** #1 Performer - Confidence Level: 5 out of 5

**BET TO PLACE:** #3 Shivaree - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

**ACROSS THE BOARD PLAY:** #5 Phat Man - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

\$125,000

## MARSHUA'S RIVER STAKES [G3]

### OVERVIEW:

The Marshua's River continues the stakes action with older fillies and mares going a mile on the turf. A solid field of 10 will battle in what looks like a pretty solid betting event. Watch for a tight finish on the wire.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A FAST PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Our Bay B Ruth, Evil Lyn, Sweet Bye and Bye*

**Pressing Speed:** *Belle Laura, Vigilantes Way*

**Stalkers:** *Lovely La La*

**Closers:** *Zofelle, Great Sister Diane, Tuned, Niko's Dream*

The pace should be especially swift with Evil Lyn shipping in for the race. Enough other speed horses in here really make things interesting.

### TOP CHOICE: #4 VIGILANTES WAY

This filly showed great consistency during her 3-year-old season, hitting the board in 7 of 8 starts and winning a local stakes last time out. She needs to turn the tables on Evil Lyn, who beat her 3 starts back, but the pace setup should be in her favor to do just that. This filly could have a nice year for Shug McGaughey.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #6 Evil Lyn, #9 Niko's Dream, #10 Sweet Bye and Bye

Evil Lyn is the class of the field and possesses the most early speed. She's who they'll all have to run down late. Niko's Dream won last time out over this track in fine fashion. Sweet Bye and Bye moves to the barn of Saffie Joseph Jr., a power switch, and she also gets Jose Ortiz to ride.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #1 Belle Laura, #2 Our Bay B Ruth, #8 Tuned

Belle Laura runs after a freshening following a nice allowance win at Churchill Downs. Our Bay B Ruth should run better in her second start off the layoff. Tuned is a consistent runner who keeps hitting the board in these types of races.

**OTHERS:** #3 Zofelle, #5 Great Sister Diane, #7 Lovely La La

These three seem a little overmatched. Each one hasn't performed up to her talent level in her last few starts.

**BET TO WIN:** #4 Vigilantes Way - Confidence Level: 4 out of 5

**BET TO PLACE:** #6 Evil Lyn - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

# RACE 8:

1 1/2 MILES (TURF)  
FILLIES & MARES 4-YEAR-OLDS & UP  
\$125,000

## LA PREVUYANTE STAKES [G3]

### OVERVIEW:

These fillies and mares stretch out to a mile and a half, which can sometimes make for strange results. The La Prevoyante kicks off the Pick 5, making it a very important race to nail.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Always Shopping*

**Pressing Speed:** *Traipsing*

**Stalkers:** *Sister Hanan, Lovely Lucky, Heavenly Curlin*

**Closers:** *Iron of Reality, Aunt Hattie, Cambeliza, Delta's Kingdom, Cap de Creus, English Affair, Court Return*

These longer races always produce a slow pace. This race should be no different, with Always Shopping and Traipsing likely settling into solid trips up front.

### TOP CHOICE: #1 ALWAYS SHOPPING

Always Shopping won the local prep for this event by 3 lengths and should have a pace advantage over her rivals here. She also seems to be the class of this field, and while she has to stretch out in distance, she finished quite strongly in her last race.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #5 Lovely Lucky, #7 Heavenly Curlin, #8 Delta's Kingdom

Lovely Lucky takes a class drop after running against tougher in her last 2 starts. Heavenly Curlin moves back to turf after winning 3 straight on Woodbine's synthetic surface. She's been running stronger as the distances get longer. Delta's Kingdom consistently hits the board in races like this.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #9 Cap de Creus, #10 English Affair, #11 Traipsing

Cap de Creus is a consistent runner who's a nice "on the board" play. English Affair is bred perfectly for this distance. Traipsing is interesting from a pace standpoint; she could be alone on the lead if Always Shopping doesn't go.

**OTHERS:** #2 Sister Hanan, #3 Irony of Reality, #4 Aunt Hattie, #6 Cambeliza, #12 Court Return

In a race at this distance, there's always a chance for an upset, but these horses leave a lot to be desired. It's hard to make a case for anyone in this bunch.

### PICKS AND PLAYS:

**BET TO WIN:** #1 Always Shopping - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

**BET TO PLACE:** #7 Heavenly Curlin - Confidence Level: 2 out of 5

# RACE 9:

7 FURLONGS (DIRT)  
FILLIES & MARES 4-YEAR-OLDS & UP  
\$200,000

## INSIDE INFORMATION STAKES [G2]

### OVERVIEW:

The Inside Information kicks off what should be a great Late Pick 4 sequence. This wide-open field of 8 could go in a ton of different ways; many of these look very similar on paper. You may have to buy your survival to advance if you're playing multi-race tickets.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Cinnabunny, Pacific Gale*

**Pressing Speed:** *Bronx Beauty, Thissmytime*

**Stalkers:** *Piedi Bianchi, Sound Machine*

**Closers:** *Dream Marie, Sally's Curlin*

Cinnabunny and Pacific Gale should be the pace setters in this spot, but with the being the only two true speed horses in the field, don't expect them to go ultra-fast early on in the race.

### TOP CHOICE: #2 CINNABUNNY

She'll try to bounce back from an odd race last time out when she finished a close third in the Sugar Swirl Stakes (G3). It was odd because she didn't get the lead, which is where she does her best running. On paper, she should get to the front in this spot, and if she does, she will be very hard to run down. Look for a nice bounce-back here.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #3 Bronx Beauty, #4 Thissmytime, #8 Sound Machine

Bronx Beauty seems to be the most consistent horse in the race and just missed last time out in the Sugar Swirl. Thissmytime comes into this event off 2 straight blowout wins against lesser company. She's ready for the next step. Sound Machine should improve from her fourth in the Sugar Swirl while stretching out to 7 furlongs.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #1 Dream Marie, #7 Sally's Curlin

After disappointing early in the season, Dream Marie got it going a bit in her last 2 starts and could be dangerous here. If there's a speed duel, Sally's Curlin will try mowing them down late. She has a great closing kick.

**OTHERS:** #5 Piedi Bianchi, #6 Pacific Gale

Piedi Bianchi seems to be a bit overmatched against this group. Pacific Gale might not be able to hang with Cinnabunny early on if those two hook up.

**BET TO WIN:** #2 Cinnabunny - Confidence Level: 3 out of 5

**BET TO PLACE:** #3 Bronx Beauty - Confidence Level: 2 out of 5

**ACROSS THE BOARD PLAY:** #4 Thissmytime - Confidence Level: 2 out of 5

**EXACTA:** 2,3,4 BOX

**TRIFECTA:** 2,3,4,8 BOX

**SUPERFACTA:** 2,3,4,8 BOX

**MULTI-RACE WAGER HORSES:** 2,3,4,8

# RACE 10:

1 1/2 MILES (TURF)  
4-YEAR-OLDS AND UP  
\$150,000

## W. L. MCKNIGHT STAKES [G3]

### OVERVIEW:

It's the boys' turn to go a mile and a half on the turf in what looks to be a wide-open affair. This field of 11 taking aim at a nice score gives bettors plenty of opportunities to find a price or two that will spice up the payouts.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Doswell, Tide of the Sea*

**Pressing Speed:** *Succeedand surpass*

**Stalkers:** *Mirinaque, Temple, Clear Vision*

**Closers:** *Tintoretto, Sadler's Joy, Sir Sahib, Sir Anthony, Channel Cat*

Doswell and Tide of the Sea will set the early tempo, but there isn't much else as far as speed horses go. The longer they race, the slower their pace.

### TOP CHOICE: #7 TIDE OF THE SEA

This true distance-type horse put that on full display 2 starts in October when he took a Keeneland allowance field gate to wire for an easy victory. He finished a decent sixth in the Fort Lauderdale Stakes (G2) last time out despite being rank early. Trainer Mike Maker is always ultra-dangerous when going long on grass.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #1 Doswell, #4 Temple, #11 Channel Cat

Doswell is the logical favorite after running second last time out in the Fort Lauderdale. He must handle stretching out in distance, though, as does Temple, the second Maker runner. At least we know Channel Cat runs well at this distance every time.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #3 Mirinaque, #5 Sadler's Joy, #9 Succeedand surpass

Mirinaque should enjoy the added ground and returning to turf. By now, we've seen Sadler's Joy fly late but not win several times. Expect more of the same here. Succeedand surpass has the breeding to suggest that he'll like stretching out in distance.

**OTHERS:** #2 Tintoretto, #6 Sir Sahib, #8 Sir Anthony, #10 Clear Vision

In a race at this distance, there's always a chance for an upset, but these horses leave a lot to be desired. It's hard to make a case for anyone in this bunch.

### PICKS AND PLAYS:

**BET TO WIN:** #7 Tide of the Sea - Confidence Level: 2.5 out of 5

**BET TO PLACE:** #1 Doswell - Confidence Level: 2 out of 5

**ACROSS THE BOARD PLAY:** #4 Temple - Confidence Level: 2 out of 5

**EXACTA:** 1,4,7 BOX

**TRIFECTA:** 1,4,7,11 BOX

**SUPERFACTA:** 1,4,7,11 BOX

**MULTI-RACE WAGER HORSES:** 1,4,7,11

**STRAIGHT WAGER:** \$5 Win/Place on #7 Tide of the Sea

# RACE 11:

1 3/16 MILES (TURF)  
4-YEAR-OLDS AND UP  
\$1,000,000

## PEGASUS WORLD CUP TURF [G1]

### OVERVIEW:

For the third straight year, the Pegasus World Cup Turf (G1) drew a solid field of runners. This year's field of 12 lacks international flavor, but it's the best betting race on the card. You can make a case for just about all of these in this classic "box 'em up and call 'em home" event.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A SLOW PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Storm the Court, Anothertwistafate*

**Pressing Speed:** *Colonel Liam*

**Stalkers:** *Breaking the Rules, Largent, Cross Border, Social Paranoia*

**Closers:** *Next Shares, North Dakota, Aquaphobia, Pixelate, Say the Word*

We shouldn't see too quick of a pace up front. Only Storm the Court and Anotherwistafate want to go early.

### TOP CHOICE: #8 ANOTHERTWISTAFATE

From a pace standpoint, he looks very strong. He has speed to go to the lead, but he can run just as well while sitting right off the speed, so Rosario will have options. Like most horses who join the Miller barn, he seems to have really improved, and he's also the only entry who's won without Lasix, which could be a major factor here as well, since the medication is not allowed in this event.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #2 Breaking the Rules, #5 Colonel Liam, #6 Largent,

Colonel Liam is a lightly-raced colt who might have the most upside in the field. Largent won the local Fort Lauderdale Stakes (G2) impressively last time out. Breaking the Rules makes a ton of sense at 10/1 in this race. He was third last time out behind Largent; however, he had a ton of trouble in the race.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #1 Next Shares, #4 North Dakota, #12 Social Paranoia

Next Shares is always a good "hit the board" candidate no matter where he enters. North Dakota was impressive in his last start, winning the Red Smith Stakes (G3). Social Paranoia looks like he's rounding back into form.

**OTHERS:** #3 Storm the Court, #7 Aquaphobia, #9 Cross Border, #10 Pixelate, #11 Say the Word

You can make a case for nearly anyone in this race, but we had to draw the line somewhere. These were the horses that we just couldn't quite get to without going really deep on our tickets.

It's time for the fifth annual Pegasus World Cup! This year's field might lack star power, but it's set up to be the best Pegasus ever from a betting standpoint. This fun event could go several different ways.

### RACE SHAPE: EXPECT A MODERATE PACE

**Pure Speed:** *Knicks Go*

**Pressing Speed:** *Sleepy Eyes Todd, Independence Hall, Tax, Mr Freeze*

**Stalkers:** *Coastal Defense, Jesus' Team, Harpers First Ride*

**Closers:** *Kiss Today Goodbye, Last Judgment, Code of Honor, Math Wizard*

There's a little bit of speed signed on, but nothing like what Knicks Go shows. He should be alone on the lead.

### TOP CHOICE: #4 KNICKS GO

He's shown "new life" since moving to the Brad Cox barn, winning 3 straight without being challenged. Last time out, he set a wicked pace in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (G1) and still held on to win with ease. The distance is a major question, but if he gets another easy lead, then he's going to be ultra-tough to pass.

**MAJOR THREATS:** #1 Sleepy Eyes Todd, #7 Tax, #10 Code of Honor

Sleepy Eyes Todd is the logical alternative to the short prices because he runs well at this distance. Tax probably ran the best race of his career last time out in the local Harlan's Holiday (G3). Code of Honor has had trouble winning races lately but is usually around with a shot when entering the stretch run.

**LONGSHOTS TO USE:** #5 Jesus' Team, #8 Harpers First Ride, #11 Mr Freeze

Jesus' Team always runs well in races like this. Harpers First Ride comes in from Laurel Park, where he's been running very well. Mr Freeze has fallen off form a bit, but he runs well over this track.

**OTHERS:** #2 Coastal Defense, #3 Independence Hall, #6 Kiss Today Goodbye, #9 Last Judgment, #12 Math Wizard

Simply put, it would be pretty shocking to see any of these horses make an impact in the race. They looked overmatched, which has happened to a lot of okay horses in the five-year history of this event.
